

// POLICY PROCEDURE //

507.0 - Student Publications

Purpose:

The purpose of this procedure is to operationalize Bismarck State College Policy 507.0 Student Publications.

Procedure:

BSC supports the right to exercise freedom of speech of students contributing to the content of student publications or other student media.

Student publications or other student media shall operate as a platform providing for the publishing of student work yielding practical experience for the students involved.

The BSC student publications and other student media shall be managed by the lead student media staff with guidance from student media advisers and academic deans following the guidelines in compliance with North Dakota State Board of Higher Education Policy 507 and North Dakota Century Code 15-10-55.

Bismarck State College officials or employees and student government officers, except those acting as members of the student media consistent with applicable laws, regulations, or policies, may not attempt to censure or exercise control, directly or indirectly, over the content of student publications and other student media.
