Subject: Service Agreement Proposal Addendum

Dear Deputy Chief Casey,

Thank you for your growing support and confidence in our Fusus technology. We are honored that the Burbank Police Department is considering expansion your Basic Package to an Enterprise Package. This agreement will parallel your existing Service Agreement Proposal currently deployed.

This Service Agreement Proposal Addendum and related software subscription will become effective upon signing and continue through December 30, 2027 and will include the following enhancements to your subscription:

- a) fususONE™: Increase of 1,350 data points and 1,350 public/private video feeds to existing agreement to now include up to 1,500 data points and 1,500 public/private video feeds
- b) fususCORE™: Provide the Following Additional Core Appliances:
 - o Forty (40) fususCORE Pro™ Appliances
 - o Five (5) fususCORE Elite AI™ Appliances
- c) fususVAULT™: Increase of 2TB of storage to now include up to 10TB of storage of videos and still images captured via the fususONE™ platform
- d) Addition of fususNOTIFY™: Implementation of our SMS text service that provides text notifications to community members
- e) Addition of fususTIPS™: Implementation of our SMS service that provides text communications of pictures, audio and video directly into fususVault
- f) Addition of fususAlert™: Implementation of our iOS/Android application which provides panic alerting to fususONE™ along with geolocation of persons in distress and automatic docking of nearby camera assets in the fususONE™ platform
- g) Addition of fusus Live Link™: Provision of a live link system which allows 911 callers to initiate a camera stream in the event of an emergency to the Department, along with a one-to-many methodology for secure and encrypted responder-group sharing during an emergency
- h) Addition of fusus Overwatch™: functionality to allow users to utilize a map to identify the cameras surrounding an incident, providing the RTC to track where an item of interest is going and which cameras they will encounter next
- i) fususCONNECT Call-Out: Three (3) months fusus call-out to businesses within the jurisdiction to assist with camera registration and integration
- j) fususINCIDENT™: Implementation of the Fusus Situational Awareness system for bi-directional telestration, icon marking, floorplan room clearing, planning, and resource staging from Emergency Operation Center workstations and mobile field-based users on laptops and iOS/Android mobile devices

Payment and Subscription Terms:

a. Payment 1: Due Contract Signing	*\$114,659
b. Payment 2: Due December 30, 2023	\$150,000
c. Payment 3: Due December 30, 2024	\$150,000
d. Payment 4: Due December 30, 2025	\$150,000
e. Payment 5: Due December 30, 2026	\$150,000

*Payment One reflects a credit of \$35,341 for services paid for but not yet used from the original Basic Package Service Agreement that was executed on December 30, 2022.

Invoices for payments 2, 3, 4 and 5 will be sent 60 days prior to their respective due dates.

All other terms and conditions outside of the terms established herein, will remain in place and supersede this amendment.
