On April 26, 2024, the Village of Burr Ridge received your written request for public records pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”). In your FOIA request, you sought information regarding the Burr Ridge Police Department’s Facebook page.

Extension

Under the Freedom of Information Act, a public body may extend the time to respond to a FOIA request by up to 5 business days for a limited number of reasons. 5 ILCS 140/3(e). We are extending the time to respond to your request by 5 business days or May 10, 2024 for the following reason:

There is a need for consultation, which shall be conducted with all practicable speed, with another public body or among two or more components of a public body having a substantial interest in the determination or in the subject matter of the request.


II. **Notice of the Right to Review by The Public Access Counselor and Notice of Right to Judicial Review**
