Good evening, Karen – I will be out of town after today until November

1. Sydney is trying to arrange for the tree removal for sometime next week, so I wanted to reach out to you and discuss your edits to the agreement which I had already signed without the edits.

1. To the point of Area of Work Property C last sentence on fencing:

CKSD will work with a fencing company to assess your fence for repair and/or replacement of fencing sections needing attention. We expect that assessment may, in fact, include some replacement of materials that are damaged beyond the ability to repair. As an example where the top rail is bent, I would not imagine this is reparable and still look new. We also expect that some fencing components may be reparable. But, we need the fencing company to advise first. We are not trying to avoid proper attention to make your fence whole. At the same time, we must be diligent to the public and treat both you and the public fairly in expensing the resolution. So, I am anticipating that where the word

"repair" is used, this will include some replacement. We have revised the wording in the attached agreement to clarify our intentions better. The revisions are noted in red to distinguish the revised content.

2. To the point of Terms of the Agreement, bullet 4:

Bullet point 4 refers to any trees that the you may elect to have removed that are in addition to outlined scope. In the case of your property, the arborist report identified 6 trees that were recommended for removal, which includes the dead madrone tree that we previously discussed removing. CKSD will cover the expense of removing the 6 trees. Any additional tree removal, beyond what has been identified to date will be the responsibility and expense of the property owner. We believe that this is a very fair and reasonable agreement.

I would ask that you recheck the trees identified for removal, as your numbers listed in the bullet at the top of page 2 are all different than the ones that we have identified for removal. The intent of this listing was to tie to those listed in the Area of Work Property C. If this is what you are referencing in Terms of Agreement (item 2 above) regarding removing these added trees, in addition to the six that were identified, this is well beyond what we could consider necessary from the arborist recommendation, or fair and reasonable. If this is the case, we may need to meet again to resolve, but hoping that we can move forward to get the work done before winter weather sets in making it less feasible this fall.

To this end, attached is an updated agreement that we hope you will sign given the above feedback.

Karen

I wanted to update you on a couple of the topics that we discussed last Friday.

Dust:

Until erosion control measures are installed in the area south of your property, we have directed the site contractor to water the soil on a periodic basis during periods of persistently dry weather. My hope is that these extra efforts, in conjunction with fewer construction vehicles performing work in the area, will improve conditions for you. Also, as you are likely aware, Skanska has installed a screen material on the construction fence in an additional effort to minimize the spread of dust across your yard.

Madrona Tree:

I met with Dale Oien today to discuss the removal of the madrona tree on your property. He said that he can take it down, but there are some logistical details for you to be aware of and agree to before proceeding.

- Due to the position of the tree relative to the others that are desired to remain, the removal will need to be performed from a lift that would be positioned in your yard adjacent to the tree. Although a reasonable

- amount of care will be taken to minimize impact, marks from the wheels of the lift may be evident in the soil and/or surrounding vegetation after the lift is removed.
- Due to the angle that the tree trunks lean toward the west (toward Douglas and Debbie's property), Dale cannot guarantee that the tree will not damage your black fence during removal. As a result Dale and the School District cannot be responsible for damage to the fence, should it occur.
- Douglas and Debbie will need to be notified and agree with Dale accessing their property to retrieve sections of tree and/or branches that may fall on their side of your fence.

Please let me know how you wish to proceed.

Fence Repair:

We have reached out to a local fencing company to determine the appropriate repairs to your black fence in the SE corner of your yard. I anticipate that a site visit may be needed to determine the extent of replacement before the corrective work is performed. If so, Stacy or I will contact you in advance to make arrangements to meet with them.

Buffer and CKSD Fence:

On Friday, I mis-stated the order of the trees and fence in the finished condition of the project. To clarify, please note the following. In order of north to south will be your existing black fence, then a single row of newly planted cedar trees, followed by a new cedar fence (approx. 6' tall). The new fence will be constructed 20' south of the shared property line.

If there are any issues that I have not addressed here that you would like more information about, please let me know.

I am sending the email below on behalf of Robin Shoemaker:

Good evening, Karen – I will be out of town after today until November 1. Sydney is trying to arrange for the tree removal for sometime next week, so I wanted to reach out to you and discuss your edits to the agreement which I had already signed without the edits.

1. To the point of Area of Work Property Clast sentence on fencing:

CKSD will work with a fencing company to assess your fence for repair and/or replacement of fencing sections needing attention. We expect that assessment may, in fact, include some replacement of materials that are damaged beyond the ability to repair. As an example where the top rail is bent, I would not imagine this is reparable and still look new. We also expect that some fencing components may be reparable. But, we need the fencing company to advise first. We are not trying to avoid proper attention to make your fence whole. At the same time, we must be diligent to the public and treat both you and the public fairly in expensing the resolution. So, I am anticipating that where the word "repair" is used, this will include some replacement. We have revised the wording in the attached agreement to clarify our intentions better. The revisions are noted in red to distinguish the revised content.

2. To the point of Terms of the Agreement, bullet 4:

Bullet point 4 refers to any trees that the you may elect to have removed that are in addition to outlined scope. In the case of your property, the arborist report identified 6 trees that were recommended for removal, which includes the dead madrone tree that we previously discussed removing. CKSD will cover the expense of removing the 6 trees. Any additional tree removal, beyond what has been identified to date will be the responsibility and expense of the property owner. We believe that this is a very fair and reasonable agreement.

I would ask that you recheck the trees identified for removal, as your numbers listed in the bullet at the top of page 2 are all different than the ones that we have identified for removal. The intent of this listing was to tie to those listed in the Area of Work Property C. If this is what you are referencing in Terms of Agreement (item 2 above) regarding removing these added trees, in addition to the six that were identified, this is well beyond what we could consider necessary from the arborist recommendation, or fair and reasonable. If this is the case, we may need to meet again to resolve, but hoping that we can move forward to get the work done before winter weather sets in making it less feasible this fall.

To this end, attached is an updated agreement that we hope you will sign given the above feedback.
