I am sending the email below on behalf of Robin Shoemaker:

Good evening, Karen – I will be out of town after today until November 1. Sydney is trying to arrange for the tree removal for sometime next week, so I wanted to reach out to you and discuss your edits to the agreement which I had already signed without the edits.

1. To the point of Area of Work Property C last sentence on fencing:

CKSD will work with a fencing company to assess your fence for repair and/or replacement of fencing sections needing attention. We expect that assessment may, in fact, include some replacement of materials that are damaged beyond the ability to repair. As an example where the top rail is bent, I would not imagine this is reparable and still look new. We also expect that some fencing components may be reparable. But, we need the fencing company to advise first. We are not trying to avoid proper attention to make your fence whole. At the same time, we must be diligent to the public and treat both you and the public fairly in expensing the resolution. So, I am anticipating that where the word "repair" is used, this will include some replacement. We have revised the wording in the attached agreement to clarify our intentions better. The revisions are noted in red to distinguish the revised content.

2. To the point of Terms of the Agreement, bullet 4:

Bullet point 4 refers to any trees that the you may elect to have removed that are in addition to outlined scope. In the case of your property, the arborist report identified 6 trees that were recommended for removal, which includes the dead madrone tree that we previously discussed removing. CKSD will cover the expense of removing the 6 trees. Any additional tree removal, beyond what has been identified to date will be the responsibility and expense of the property owner. We believe that this is a very fair and reasonable agreement.

I would ask that you recheck the trees identified for removal, as your numbers listed in the bullet at the top of page 2 are all different than the ones that we have identified for removal. The intent of this listing was to tie to those listed in the Area of Work Property C. If this is what you are referencing in Terms of Agreement (item 2 above) regarding removing these added trees, in addition to the six that were identified, this is well beyond what we could consider necessary from the arborist recommendation, or fair and reasonable. If this is the case, we may need to meet again to resolve, but hoping that we can move forward to get the work done before winter weather sets in making it less feasible this fall.

To this end, attached is an updated agreement that we hope you will sign given the above feedback.

If trunk sections are retained by the Property Owner, CKSD is not responsible for cutting the logs into sections smaller than 8'.

- When the aforementioned work is finished, this will conclude the District's agreement and responsibilities regarding this matter. Future tree assessment or removal, if desired by the property owner, will be the responsibility and expense of the property owner.
- CKSD is not responsible for the condition or longevity of trees that remain on residential property.
- If there is a dispute as to whether CKSD removed an incorrect tree, CKSD's liability to the property owner shall only be to remove a tree that the property owner believes was required to be removed per this agreement. CKSD and its contractor shall not be liable for any damages for removing an incorrect tree.
- Except for the costs of performing the work described in this agreement, CKSD is not responsible to the property owner for any other costs or expenses of any kind.

I received your revised quote for the tree removal at the residential properties north of the CK campus. Hoping you can help me understand the reason for such a significant cost increase.

Back in July the tree removal from 2 properties was quoted at \$3,500 total. The quote did not quantify the number of trees to be removed, but I recall that it was roughly 6-8 trees on each parcel. As discussed last week, we now want to remove trees from 3 properties, but the total number of trees is not significantly greater than what was discussed last July.
