Thank you for contacting us about an incident at 1141 hrs. on 09/20/2019 in the area of [REDACTED].

We researched the referenced incident and located audio closely matching the incident details. Upon further research we have determined that Incident 614-30389 was misclassified as OT. We have reclassified this incident to reflect the accurate classification of SG.

This incident will be added into our training materials and analyzed further to better understand the root cause of misclassification and help prevent this from occurring in the future. We take great strides to accurately classify incidents.

To help with our training, I just have one follow up question. Do you happen to have the caliber of the gun?
