Re: Public Records Request to the Eastham Police Department, dated January 26, 2024

Dear Attorney Stathulis:

The Eastham Police Department (the "Police Department") received your public records request via fax on January 26, 2024. Your request was dated with the same date. Please find the Police Department's response to these requests in accordance with the Public Records Law as contained herein.

SUMMARY OF YOUR REQUEST:

In your request you provided the following **definitions**:

"A school-related arrest" "[r]efers to an arrest of a student for any activity conducted on school grounds, during off campus school activities (including while taking school transportation), or due to a referral by any school official. All school-related arrests are considered referrals to law enforcement."

"A referral to law enforcement" "[i]s an action by which a student is reported to any law enforcement agency or official, including a school police unit, for an incident that occurs on school grounds, during school-related events, or while taking school transportation, regardless of whether official action is taken. Citations, tickets, court referrals, and school-related arrests are considered referrals to law enforcement."

YOU HAVE REQUESTED: (all in italic print)

5. The cost to the school district of assigning a school resource officer to each school; and,

7. The total number and a brief description of 911 calls from schools in your district to local police departments conducted during the 2018-2019, 2019-2020, 2020-2021, and 2021-2022, and,

RECORDS NOT IN POSSESSION OF THE EASTHAM POLICE DEPARTMENT:

"If such an extract of the database in question 1 is not possible, please provide school incident reports on each school-related arrest and referral to law enforcement conducted during the 2018-2019, 2019-2020, 2020-2021, and 2021-2022 school year (up until the day the records are produced)."

Please be advised that the Eastham Police Department does not have possession, custody or control of: **"school incident reports"** on each school-related arrest and referral to law enforcement" created by school employees.

The mandatory disclosure provision of the Public Records Law only applies to information that is in the custody of the Police Department at the time the request is received. As a result, there is no obligation for a Department to create a record for a requester to honor a request. See G.L. c. 4, section 7(26) (defining "public records" as materials which have already been "made or received" by a public entity); see also 32 Op. Att'y Gen. 157, 165 (May 18, 1977) (custodian is not obliged to create a record in response to a request for information); see also A Guide to the Massachusetts Public Records Law, Secretary of the Commonwealth, Division of Public Records, p. 7 (January 2013) (hereinafter Public Records Guide).

As a result, the Police Department is unable to respond to this portion of your request. However, the records requested may be in the possession, custody or control of the Nausett Regional School District.

EXEMPTIONS FOR WITHHOLDING EASTHAM POLICE RECORDS AND DATA:

The Police Department intends to withhold certain requested data, records and reports that are in the possession of the Police Department, as these records contain and are intertwined with legally

protected information, and contain information that could be used to identify the confidentiality of persons who are legally protected. The Police Department intends to withhold the above-referenced requested Police Department data, records, and reports due to the applicability of the following exemptions and the reasons set forth below:

1. EXEMPTION (a): This exemption applies to records that are "specifically or by necessary implication exempt from disclosure by statute." Exemption (a) to the Public Records Law, G.L. c. 4, §7(26)(a), applies to records which are "specifically or by necessary implication exempted from disclosure by statute."

The requested records, which contain information regarding identified minors, may be withheld pursuant to G.L. c. 214, § 1B as that statute operates through Exemption (a). Massachusetts G.L. c. 214, § 1B affords individuals a right against the unreasonable, substantial or serious interference with their privacy.

Since the requested records contain identifying information regarding minors/students, such information is specifically exempt from disclosure and has been withheld as noted herein.

CRIMINAL OFFENDER RECORD INFORMATION

In particular, G.L. c. 6, sections 167-178B, and related regulations, requires that criminal justice agencies withhold any records and data in any communicable form compiled by a Massachusetts criminal justice agency which concern an identifiable individual and relate to the nature or disposition of a criminal charge, an arrest, a pre-trial proceeding, other judicial proceedings, previous hearings conducted pursuant to section 58A of chapter 276 where the defendant was detained prior to trial or released with conditions under subsection (2) of section 58A of chapter 276, sentencing, incarceration, rehabilitation, or release. Such information shall be restricted to that recorded in criminal proceedings that are not dismissed before arraignment. Criminal offender record information shall not include evaluative information, statistical and analytical reports and files in which individuals are not directly or indirectly identifiable, or intelligence information. Criminal offender record information shall be limited to information concerning persons who have attained the age of 18 and shall not include any information concerning criminal offenses or acts of delinquency committed by any person before he attained the age of 18; provided, however, that if a person under the age of 18 is adjudicated as an adult, information relating to such criminal offense shall be criminal offender record information. Criminal offender record information shall not include information concerning any offenses which are not punishable by incarceration.

DOMESTIC ABUSE & SEXUAL ASSAULT CASES

In particular, G.L. c. 41, section 97D requires law enforcement agencies to keep the following information confidential: "All reports of rape and sexual assault or attempts to commit such offenses, all reports of abuse perpetrated by family or household members, as defined in section 1 of chapter 209A, and all communications between police officers and victims of such offenses or abuse..."

VICTIM INFORMATION

In particular, G.L. c. 66, section 10B advises that the home address, telephone number, personal email address or place employment or education of victims of adjudicated crimes, of victims of domestic violence and of persons providing or training in family planning services and the name, home address, telephone number, personal email address or place of employment or education of a family member of any of the foregoing shall not be public records.

JUVENILE & MINOR INFORMATION

The requested records, which contain information regarding identified minors, may be withheld pursuant to G.L. c. 214, § 1B as that statute operates through Exemption (a). Massachusetts G.L. c. 214, § 1B affords individuals a right against the unreasonable, substantial or serious interference with their privacy.

Since the requested records contain identifying information regarding minors/students, such information is specifically exempt from disclosure and has been withheld as noted herein.

"When responding to requests for information about juveniles, police and prosecutors are guided by the intent of the legislature to provide broadly for the confidentiality of juvenile records. See Police Comm'r of Boston v. EXEMPTION (c):

This exemption applies to "personnel and medical files or information; also any other materials or data relating to a specifically named individual, the disclosure of which may constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy."

Aside from personnel and medical information, the courts have held that Exemption (c) is designed to protect from public disclosure a variety of personal information, including: marital status, paternity, substance abuse, government assistance, family disputes and reputation. *People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals (PETA) v. Dep't of Agric. Res.*, 477 Mass 280, 292 (2017). In deciding whether there is a privacy interest in requested records and the weight to be accorded any such interest, "we have looked to three factors ... : (1) whether disclosure would result in personal embarrassment to an individual of normal sensibilities; (2) whether the materials sought contain intimate details of a highly personal nature; and (3) whether the same information is available from other sources" (footnote omitted). *PETA*, 477 Mass. at 292, citing *Globe Newspaper Co. v. Police Comm'r of Boston*, 419 Mass. 852,858 (1995) ("*Police Comm'r of Boston*"). "[O]ther case-specific relevant factors' may [also] influence the calculus." *PETA*, supra, quoting *Police Comm'r of Boston*, supra.

The records requested contain information which, if disclosed, would constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy to minors and juveniles, and such information contains intimate details and the privacy interests involved outweigh the public interests in the disclosure of that information.

EXEMPTION (f):

This exemption applies to "investigatory materials necessarily compiled out of the public view by law enforcement or other investigatory officials the disclosure of which materials would probably so prejudice the possibility of effective law enforcement that such disclosure would not be in the public interest." While this exemption is not a blanket exemption it applies to such information, the disclosure of which would prejudice investigative efforts. In particular, it applies to information related to ongoing investigations, confidential investigative techniques and information which directly or indirectly identifies witnesses or informants. The records requested contain juvenile and minor information as victims and witnesses, and as a result, such information must be redacted under the law.

RESPONSE TO YOUR REQUEST:

In accordance with the aforementioned exemptions to the public records law and cited case law, the Police Department has "withheld" items with the notation: "withheld", and otherwise provided the following information as requested:

1. *"An extract of your records management system or database that includes each school-related arrest and each referral to law enforcement conducted during the 2018-2019, 2019-2020, 2020-2021, and 2021-2022 school year (up until the day the records are produced)..."*
