I am the community policing specialist and crime analyst for the Euclid Police Department and I have accepted a request from Captain Jeff Cutwright to serve on the collaborative board for the reduction in violent crime initiative. Managing crime numbers and generating statistical reports and crime bulletins is my responsibility, so I am able to extend this service to include micro-areas of violent crime for the quarterly collaboration meetings.

Along with attending quarterly meetings, I will provide police officers with current crime data on a weekly basis which will assist them in their engagement and enforcement efforts. I will use the computer aided dispatch system and records management system to collect criminal offense and arrest data, as well as positive encounters the officers will have in the micro-areas. Please accept this letter as my support and commitment to the Reduction in Violent Crime grant. I will be serving as the Community Policing and Response Units' supervisor beginning in 2022. In this role I will be responsible for implementation and management of officers detailed to the proactive policing Response Unit and possibly this grant.

My experience as a police officer, Sergeant, and community liaison has been firmly rooted in developing, promoting and implementing various community initiatives outside of my patrol supervisor responsibilities, such as the Crossover Classic 3-on-3 Basketball Tournament, Teen Summit, and Project BLUEPRINT. The Tournament, Summit and BLUEPRINT were developed to help bridge the community, in specific youth, by providing opportunities for them to engage and build healthy relationships with police in a positive environment.

Additionally, I was one of the first patrol officers assigned to the Community Response Unit from 2015-2018, which focused heavily on narcotics and gun interdiction. At that time I attended various community events where I was able to speak with residents regarding various public safety related concerns and police department functions. During the Response Units implementation we were very successful in seizing numerous illegally carried firearms on a yearly basis that could have been used in other violent crimes. Currently, due to the rise in violent crime nationwide and specifically gun violence in major metropolitan inner ring suburbs, such as Euclid-Ohio, it is essential that we begin to re-engage in proactive policing efforts. This will provide continued support for keeping the community safe for residents, businesses, and officers.

I have a diverse experience outside of policing where I volunteer on non-profit boards and work with organizations to achieve their goals. I understand what it takes to implement and evaluate programs when provided the proper resources. Any financial support you provide will assist us in our desire to reduce violent crimes in our neighborhoods that will hopefully have a rippling effect to surrounding communities.
