items in plain view within the vehicle's back seat including a large pack of Great Value paper towels, a large case of Coca Cola, an item still in a clear theft protection case and a large pack of canned dog food. There was additionally a small Michael Kors purse on the front seat and a Nissan key fob on the front passenger floorboard. The RP then left the scene.

I then made contact in the Loss Prevention Office with Loss Prevention Officer (LPO) Jacquelyn Medina, who was unaware of the incident. Medina did advise that she was tracking a white female wearing glasses and a dark colored zip up hooded sweatshirt with the hood pulled up over her head, on camera walking around the store and exiting the grocery side of the store past all points of sale with a cart full of items. Medina watched on surveillance footage as the female walk towards the north end of the parking lot before turning east at the edge of the parking lot and walking to the area where the vehicle was located containing what appeared to be items from the shopping cart spread across the back seat. It is to be noted that none of the items in the vehicle were in bags, which indicates that they were not paid for in the store, or properly packaged as a reasonable person would package merchandise they purchased from a department store.

As I was walking back to the vehicle to have Medina come confirm that the items were one and the same as observed in the vehicle, I observed a female fitting the suspect's description, walking towards the store approximately 2 rows away. I advised the female to stop and speak to me which she did without issue. The female was positively identified by her Florida Identification Card as Amber Delaney Mccann. I advised Mccann of the reason for our interaction. She then spontaneously uttered that it was about a "cart that was loaded and the items placed into a car, yeah that was me".

When I asked what vehicle she had placed the items in Mccann advised "I put it in a random car that was open" because "yall" (law enforcement) was coming. She additionally advised that she left her ID and purse in the random vehicle which was white or silver. Mccann stated she was playing a game called "21" where someone grabs as much merchandise from a store and walks out with said items without purchasing them. She was boasting about how fun it was even though it was considered theft to law enforcement. Mccann stated that she placed all the items in a random vehicle along with her purse which happened to be a Michael Kors purse. Mccann was then secured in handcuffs for the duration of the investigation and placed in the rear of Deputy O. Schrager's Flagler County Sheriff's Office patrol vehicle.

After being placed in the patrol vehicle, Mccann advised that she was lying before about the vehicle being random and it was a vehicle that her boyfriend Michael Campbell rented, but he was unaware that she had

stolen any items and was inside shopping. Deputy O. Schrager then advised Mccann of her Miranda Warnings to which she reiterated everything that she previously uttered post Miranda. I then requested that Medina come to the vehicle in the parking lot to identify the items. She agreed that the items in the vehicle belonged to Walmart and were not paid for. The items were then turned over to Medina who inventoried them and provided me with an itemized receipt totaling \$1032.51 U.S Currency, for 101 items including personal hygiene items, dog food, and housewares.

While the stolen merchandise was being removed from the vehicle by Deputy O. Schrager, SGT F. Gamarra advised that he detected a clear and distinct odor of marijuana emanating from within the vehicle. During a probable cause search of the vehicle, SGT F. Gamarra and K9 Deputy Robin Towns located a partially burnt marijuana cigarette in the center console area. Due to the fact the stolen merchandise was in extent of \$1000.00 U.S Currency, the vehicle was used in the commission of a felony (grand theft-shoplifting), and the vehicle was owned by a rental company called 347744 Cars LLC, SGT F. Gamarra advised that the vehicle would be seized for forfeiture and an inventory search was completed in accordance with FCSO General Order 448.

During the inventory search, two safes were located in the trunk area of the vehicle, a small black one which was unlocked and a large gray one that was locked. The small safe contained prescription medication that belonged to Mccann. Mccann denied any knowledge of the safes and could not provide a combination. In accordance with FCSO General Order 448, the large gray safe was opened using SGT F. Gamarra's FCSO issued breaching equipment. Inside, Deputies located various 1oz Sunshine Mint silver bars and rounds, copper bars and 1 gram platinum bars, gold fossil watch, along with medication and documentation belonging to Campbell. Additionally, SGT F. Gamarra located a small locked black case which contained two clear plastic baggies with a clear crystalline substance inside as well as a baggie containing 2 yellow rectangular 2mg tablets identified as Alprazolam, which is a schedule 4 controlled substance. The crystalline substance was tested by K9 Deputy R. Townes utilizing a Lynn Peavy Methamphetamine field test kit which gave a presumptive positive result for methamphetamine which was verified by SGT F. Gamarra.

Inside the trunk, I located a red cloth inside of a square plastic bucket that was wrapped around a glass pipe with a bulbous end. The pipe appeared to have burnt residue which is usually used in the smoking and inhalation of illicit substances. Inside the safe, there were empty plastic bags like the ones used to package the previously located

narcotics. SGT F. Gamarra advised that based upon his Law Enforcement training and experience in narcotics investigations, the narcotics located within the safe are packaged for distribution, and the digital scale and empty plastic bags are used for selling and distributing narcotics.

Based on the fact that the narcotics as well as the silver, copper, and platinum bars (which are form of useable currency), were located together in the safe, there is reason to believe that the items are proceeds of the sale of narcotics. The silver, copper, and platinum bars along with the vehicle are being seized for forfeiture. All items of evidentiary value were photographed and packaged accordingly. The vehicle was transported via Rogers Towing to the FCSO impound lot located at 1001 Justice Lane, Bunnell, FL 32110.

Let it be known that Campbell was not located while deputies were on scene and the vehicle's key fob was located in the vehicle close to Mccann's purse on the passenger side of the vehicle.

In total, 4 baggies containing methamphetamine were located weighing approximately 28g, 28g, 4g, and 2g respectively for a total packaged weight of 62g. The marijuana and an approximate unpackaged weight of 11g. Additionally in the trunk, a plastic container containing marijuana residue, a glass "water pipe" with a large water holding chamber at the bottom and additional glass tubes usually used for smoking and inhaling illicit narcotics were located.

Based on the fact that McCann admitted to stealing merchandise from Walmart and placing it in her vehicle, the fact that narcotics and paraphernalia were located within the vehicle and Mccann being the sole occupant, to include having items in the trunk area with her name, indicating that she had knowledge that safes and secured containers were present, and that she had access and control of those areas, probable cause exists to place Mccann under arrest for Shoplifting-Grand Theft \$750-\$5K, possession of marijuana 20g or less, possession of hashish, possession of drug paraphernalia, and trafficking of methamphetamine 28g-200g, and possession of Alprazolam.

During a criminal history search, Mccann was found to have one previous charge of Petit Theft less than \$100.00, which resulted in no conviction in Duval County, FL, in 2014. (ref 162014MM004430AXXXMA).

Medina completed Sworn Written Statement and Willingness to Prosecute forms on behalf of Walmart which were submitted to the Flagler County Sheriff's Office Records.

Medina provided me with a receipt listing the items stolen and a copy of the surveillance footage on a cd to
