Case Overview

LARCENY CASE THAT OCCURRED AT WALMART, 174 CYRPESS POINT PKWY, PALM COAST. DURING THE INVESTIGATION, VARIOUS NARCOTICS, SILVER, COPPER AND PLATNIUM BARS WERE LOCATED. ONE FEMALE WAS PLACED UNDER ARREST AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT. A MALE WAS IDENTIFED TO BE WITH THE FEMALE BUT UNKNOWN THE WHICH ITEMS AND NARCOTICS COULD POSSIBLY BE RELATED TO THE MALE THAT WAS IDENTIFIED. A LARGE AMOUNT OF DOCUMENTS WERE LOCATED RELATED TO THE MALE BUT KNOWN IF CONNECTED TO FELONIOUS USE OR CRIMINAL ACTIVITY.

CSI Narrative

On 03/26/24, Sergeant Miller 344 requested CSI process evidence items 1075.15, 1075.17, 1075.19, for latent prints and DNA. A digital camera was used to take color photographs of the following items:

- 1075.15 Clear plastic baggie previously containing a white crystal substance
- 1075.17 Clear plastic baggie
- 1075.19 Clear plastic bag

The zipper of each baggie was swabbed for possible DNA evidence. The following evidence items were collected:

- 1169.1 swab of zipper on baggie (1075.15)
- 1169.2 swab of zipper on baggie (1075.17)
- 1169.3 swab of zipper on baggie (1075.19)

The items were properly packaged, sealed and submitted to evidence on 03/26/24.

The baggies were exposed to cyanoacrylate ester fumes, a product of heated Superglue. The baggies were viewed with white light and no usable ridge detail was observed. The baggies were dipped in fluorescent dye and then viewed with an alternate light source. No usable ridge detail was observed.

The items were properly repackaged, resealed, and returned to property.
