SCENE DESCRIPTION:

On 8/27/24 at approximately 5pm, I, CSI Massa #1095 was contacted by Sergeant Hristakopoulos regarding a search warrant that would be taking place at the above listed address. The search warrant was in reference to a BOLO of a blue Ferrari 488 Spyder with Florida Tag CCC1 that had parked in the backyard of the residence.

The residence was a single story with the front door facing south-west. There were four (4) bedrooms, two (2) bathrooms, and an attached garage.

NARRATIVE:

Observations

Multiple FCSO Detectives and Deputies were all on scene to aid in executing the search warrant.

To the left of the residence, linear marks through the grass that appeared to be tire marks were observed.

The vehicle had a red tarp over it and was found in the backyard of the residence near the wood lining. There was no exterior damage noted on the vehicle.

Entry was made into the residence via front door. The bedrooms and kitchen area appeared to be lived in.

The following was found in the residence:

- In the back of the garage by the water heater a firearm was found on top of one of the water heater tanks
- Miscellaneous paraphernalia was found scattered throughout the residence
- Detective Gordon attempted to call Costa's cell phone number associated with his phone and it was found in the garbage

CSI cleared the scene at 9:15pm.

Processing (SCENE)

Overall, midrange, and close-up photographs were taken of the scene and the items found within using a DSLR camera.

Multiple swabs of the exterior of the vehicle were taken. The exterior passenger side door was processed for latent prints using black powder and a microfiber brush: No prints of value were found.

A tow truck company was contacted for the Ferrari. The Ferrari was sealed and initialed with evidence tape and towed to the Forensic garage bay.

Items of evidence from the scene were transported to the FCSO Forensic Laboratory and stored in a temporary locker until further notice.

No further action was taken.

Processing (LAB) 8.28.24

On 8/28/24, item #1095.6 was turned over to Digital Forensics.

Items 1095.1-.7 were packaged, sealed, initialed, and submitted directly to evidence.

Items 932.1-6 were all taken for destruction.

No further action was taken.

Processing (LAB) VEHICLE 10.18.24

On 10/18/24 at approximately 2:10pm, Detective Gordon and I, CSI Massa, conducted a search for the Ferrari. Entrance was made to search the interior of the vehicle.

Photographs of the interior and exterior of the vehicle were taken. There was no damage noted to the interior of the vehicle. Multiple swabs of the interior of the vehicle were taken.

Attempts to open the trunk of the vehicle were made but all attempts were unsuccessful without a key fob associated to the vehicle being present.

Detective Gordon would make attempts to retrieve keys from the owner so access to the trunk could be made. Processing ended at 4:00pm.

A towing company was contacted for the Ferrari. It was transported from the Forensic garage bay to the impound lot.

No further action was taken.

Processing (IMPOUND) 10.29.24

On 10/29/24 at approximately 1:00pm, a key fob was obtained from the owner and Detective Gordon and I, CSI Massa, conducted a search of the trunk of the vehicle at the impound lot.

Photographs of the vehicle and the trunk were taken. There was nothing of value in the trunk of the vehicle.

CSI left the impound lot at 2:28pm.

Detective Gordon submitted the vehicle keys directly to evidence.

No further action was taken.
