**RE: Public Records Act Request** 

Dear Sophia Ludt,

This letter responds to your California Public Records Act ("CPRA") request, submitted to the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk ("County") on 06/14/2024. Specifically, you requested the following information:

"Pursuant to California Public Records Act § 6250 et seq., The most recent contract (i.e. council resolution, contract extension, contract amendments, cure notices, or other revisions to agreements) between the city and SoundThinking, Inc., formerly ShotSpotter, Inc.. This document(s) should include the total cost over the life of the contract and the current expiration date. The requested documents will be made available to the general public, and this request is not being made for commercial purposes. In the event that there are fees, I would be grateful if you would inform me of the total charges in advance of fulfilling my request. I would prefer the request filled electronically, by e-mail attachment if available or CD-ROM if not. Thank you in advance for your anticipated cooperation in this matter. I look forward to receiving your response to this request within 10 calendar days, as the statute requires."

Under the CPRA, the County has a duty to disclose records to the public to the extent the County understands the request, responsive records exist and can be located, and the information contained in the responsive records are not subject to, in whole or in part, legal exemptions from disclosure. However, the CPRA does not require the County to answer questions or to create a record that does not exist at the time of the request. (See Cal. Gov. Code § 7920.530; Haymie v. Superior Court (2001) 26 Cal.4th 1061, 1075.)

Based on the information provided in your request, and to the extent the County understands the request, the County has conducted a diligent search and could not locate records responsive to your request.
