Organizer [REDACTED] [REDACTED] advised the group expected possible presence from opposition, including White Lives Matter. Officers observed the event and found a single agitator, identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] near the beginning of the event. [REDACTED] was not masked and was identified from previous encounters, his vehicle, and video posted on Facebook by bystanders.

The majority of the event was uneventful with no opposition as [REDACTED] had left and no other subjects arrived. Toward the end of the event four (4) subjects in masks arrived and stood on the north side of Grand River near Coratti's restaurant. They waived flags and used a bullhorn and argued back and forth with several bystanders. The subjects eventually left the area in a U-Haul box truck. LCSO Deputy Topolski completed a traffic stop on the vehicle and the driver was identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was the only occupant of the 4 to provide ID. LCSO Deputies completed their stop and the subjects were released without further. Ofc. John took a suspicious for a report of shoving back and forth between White Lives Matter subjects and bystanders. See that report for further.

[REDACTED] was observed by Officers approaching a Nazi group and antagonizing them. He got chest to chest with one of the protestors and was then pushed.
