Tree spikes deployed in "Poor Windy" BLM old growth timber sale

(5/3/24, Billings MT)- The project required that eleven of us spend nine days in God awful weather conditions spiking trees. We unloaded a total of five hundred pounds of spikes measuring 8 to 10 inches in length. The sales were marked so that no workers would be injured and so that you assholes know that they are spiked. The majority of trees were spiked within the first ten feet, but many, many others were spiked as high as a hundred and fifty feet. Good thing you don't log old growth.
