## Dep Grayson Narrative

On 05/21/22 at approximately 14:17 hours, I, Deputy Grayson #249, was dispatched to [REDACTED] for a domestic disturbance. The caller, David Miller, stated that his [REDACTED], was out of control, hitting [REDACTED] parents, screaming and yelling, and breaking things.

Sgt. Bauer, Deputy Schwerman, and I arrived on scene. I approached the residence and did not hear an active disturbance going on. I walked into the residence and observed [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] room, crying on [REDACTED] bed. When Sgt. Bauer asked [REDACTED] what had happened, [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] dad, David, was telling [REDACTED] to clean [REDACTED] room and was standing to close to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] thought [REDACTED] dad was taunting [REDACTED] and it had upset [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] then stated that [REDACTED] was pushing, slapping, and kicking [REDACTED] dad. Sgt. Bauer advised [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] should not be hitting [REDACTED] parents.

I spoke with Linda who stated the following: [REDACTED] was supposed to clean [REDACTED] room and wanted a break but had one all morning. Linda told [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] needed to clean [REDACTED] room. [REDACTED] stated "No I'm running away. You can't stop me". Linda got a call from a lady who stated she picked [REDACTED] up out in the county on a road by the curves just outside of town. David went and picked [REDACTED] up and took [REDACTED] home. [REDACTED] got home and began to cuss, slam doors, and put a hole in the wall using [REDACTED] feet. [REDACTED] then threw a boot and hit Linda in the face and right upper chest leaving a red mark. Sgt. Bauer took photographs of the red mark for evidence. [REDACTED] then grabbed perfume and attempted to spray it in Linda's eyes. [REDACTED] began to pour lotion on Linda, and attempted to bite Linda. Linda stated she attempted to hold [REDACTED] down, [REDACTED] then kicked Linda in the back. Linda stated [REDACTED] started to calm down but continued to throw things at her. Linda stated while David was on the phone with dispatch, [REDACTED] kicked him in the stomach and hit him in the face.

I spoke with David who stated the following: He told [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] could not go to a friend's house and needed to clean [REDACTED] room. [REDACTED] then stated [REDACTED] was going to run away. David stated that they let [REDACTED] leave the house to walk and calm down. David stated that he and his wife received a call from a lady, who stated she stopped [REDACTED] out in the county and had [REDACTED] stay there. David went to pick [REDACTED] up. David stated when they got home [REDACTED] started to escalate and tried to break windows. David attempted to restrain [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] began to calm down. David let [REDACTED] go and that was when [REDACTED] kicked David in the stomach with both feet. [REDACTED] then hit David in the 3-4 times in the face. I did not observe any marks on David's face. [REDACTED] stated she was going to kill David and wanted to kill [REDACTED].

Deputy Schwerman requested Logan County Paramedics to come to the scene for [REDACTED] to be transported to Lincoln Memorial ER for a mental health evaluation. Logan County Paramedics Association (LCPA) arrived on scene shortly after. LCPA transported [REDACTED] to Lincoln Memorial to be medically evaluated. Linda and David followed LCPA to the hospital to complete the involuntary committal form.

David and Linda were both issued the Illinois Domestic Violence Victim Information Act Form. I went over the form with David and Linda to explain their options. I asked David and Linda if they would be willing to complete a written statement. David and Linda both agreed and complete a written statement forms. The written statements were then submitted with this report. I uploaded the photos that were taken on scene to a CD that was submitted in to evidence. Another copy of the photos was burnt to a CD and submitted with this report.
