On 06/08/22 at approximately 12:43 hours, Logan Dispatch received a call stating a ■ year old ■ was battering two elderly women. Logan Dispatch stated they could not get much information out of the caller due to her crying. Logan Dispatch stated that there was prior call history at this residence with an ■. Logan Dispatch stated a Lincoln Police Department Officer was in the area and could respond.

Sgt. Bauer and I arrived on scene to speak with Lincoln Police, Officer Lynn. Officer Lynn stated that when he arrived the ■ year old ■ was already in ■ room laying in ■ bed. I spoke with the Grandma Iva Becker who stated ■ wanted to lay down to take a nap, and had become aggressive. Iva Stated that ■ had started to bite and pull ■ mom Valerie Nance's hair.

I spoke with Valerie who called while speaking with Valerie. I observed Valerie had bite and claw marks on her right arm, and was pulling hair from her head. Valerie stated that the doctor had changed ■ medication approximately 3 weeks ago and had a doctor's appointment next week. I asked Valerie what had happened she stated that her ■ and she were in ■ room when ■ had an aggressive outburst and attacked her. Valerie stated that over the last couple weeks ■ has become more aggressive. Valerie stated she normally does not go into ■ room alone, but was just trying to get ■ to take a nap. I asked Valerie if she needed any medical attention. Valerie stated that she did not.

Logan County Paramedic Association arrived on scene, I advised them of the situation. Logan County Paramedics were able to get ■ out of ■ room and to walk out to the ambulance. ■ got into the back of the ambulance and was transported to Lincoln Memorial Hospital.
