Dep Grayson Narrative

On 06/28/22 at approximately 0345 hours, Cpl Hopp and I were patrolling westbound on [REDACTED], Logan Dispatch called out a welfare check at [REDACTED] residence. I know this to be Doug Garber's residence from prior police contacts there. Logan stated Glenda Grass called stating that Doug was going to kill himself and had bullets but was unsure if he had a gun.

I arrived to the residence. I heard Doug in the garage and watched him walk into the house. Glenda opened the door. I walked into the residence and walked behind Doug, as he walked into the bathroom. Doug stated that he felt like he was going to get sick. I talked to Doug and asked him what was going on. Doug stated that Glenda and he got into an argument and he was upset. Doug stated Glenda was going to leave him.

Doug stated that he was going to kill himself because he was upset and mad. I asked Doug if he had a plan of how he was going to kill himself. Doug stated that he did not have a plan. I asked Doug why he had the bullets, he stated that he did not know because he did not have a gun. I did not observe a gun near or about Doug. I asked Doug if he had any guns in the house. Doug stated he did not and the two guns that he did have were stolen. I collected the ammunition for evidence. I logged the rifle rounds in to evidence.

I had Logan Dispatch start Logan County Paramedics Association. I talked with Doug and advised him that he needed to be seen and get medically evaluated. Doug stated that he just needed to get back on his medication. Logan County Paramedics Association arrived shortly after. Logan County Paramedics transported Doug to Lincoln Memorial Hospital. I completed the involuntary paperwork for Doug and left Doug in the custody of the Hospital nursing staff.
