Dep. Grasyon Narrative

On 06/03/22 at approximately 0306 hours, I was southbound on North Jefferson St traveling to Woodlawn St Lincoln IL, I observed a white SUV turn on to Woodlawn without signaling. I pulled behind the vehicle and observed the plates to be expired of 02/22. I activated my emergency lights and initiated a traffic stop. We came to a stop at [REDACTED].

I approached the passenger side of the vehicle. The female driver, later identified as Nichole Tennison, asked why I was at the passenger side. I advised her that was just the side I walked to. I asked Nichole to roll the window all the way down for me. Nichole began to cry stating she was going to jail. I asked Nichole to exit the vehicle and to come speak with me at my squad car. I asked the male passenger William Brunner for his license. William provided me with his license. Nichole got into the passenger seat of my squad car. I asked Nichole for her full name and birthday. Nichole provided me with her information. Nichole came back clear of warrants and suspended. Nichole stated she was suspended and shouldn't be driving. I asked Nichole whose vehicle she was driving. Nichole stated it was her boyfriend's, Brett Rachall. Nichole stated he was in jail, and was trying to sell the vehicle. I asked Nichole if the owner, Teresa Rachall, knew she had the truck. Nichole stated she did. I asked Nichole if there was anything illegal in the vehicle. Nichole stated there was [REDACTED] in the middle console. I ran William's information in my squad car. William came back clear of warrants and suspended. I advised Nichole to stay in my squad car while I speak with the passenger.

I asked William to exit the vehicle and to come back to my squad car. I asked William if there was anything illegal on his person. William emptied his pockets. I advised William to sit against the hood of my squad car. I began to search the vehicle. I located a clear plastic baggie with [REDACTED] inside of it located in the middle console. I logged the [REDACTED] into evidence to be later destroyed. I completed searching the vehicle and did not locate any other contraband in the vehicle. I requested next available towing service through Logan Dispatch. Logan Dispatch advised RBC Towing was in route to my location. RBC Towing arrived shortly after.

I issued Nichole a citation for driving with a suspended license citation #228101. I issued Nichole a [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. I advised Nichole she was free to leave. RBC Towing took possession of the vehicle. Nichole and William left with no other incident.

I placed a copy of the in-car audio/video recording onto a DVD and placed it into evidence. I also created another CD copy and forwarded it to the Logan County State's Attorney's Office along with this report.
