### **Dep. Grayson Narravtive**

On 07/11/2 at approximately 1200 hours, I was southbound on North Kickapoo St Lincoln IL, I observed a tan ford explorer with obstructed registration plate. I observed the male not to have a seat belt on. I activated my emergency lights and initiated a traffic stop. We came to a stop at North Kickapoo St / Oklahoma Ave.

I approached the driver side of the vehicle and could smell a strong odor of cannabis coming from the vehicle. I observed the driver to be putting his seat belt on as I was approaching. I asked the male driver, later identified as Sean Samples, for his license and proof of insurance. I asked Sean to exit the vehicle and come to the rear of his vehicle due to a dog being in the vehicle. Sean handed me his license and stated he needed to get on his phone for insurance. Sean stated that his license was expired. I ran Sean's information through Logan Dispatch. Logan Dispatch stated Sean was expired and clear of warrants.

I asked Sean if there was going to be drug contraband in the vehicle. I observed the left carotid artery to be pulsing as if Sean was nervous. I observed Sean's hands start to shake and I found this odd due to Sean's hands not shaking when he handed me his license. From my training and experience, I know both of these to be signs of nervousness. Sgt. Bauer arrived on Scene. I advised Sean that when I approached his vehicle I could smell a strong odor of cannabis coming from the vehicle. Sean stated that his car should not smell like cannabis because he has none in the vehicle. I asked Sean to empty his pockets for me on the hood of my squad car. Sean pulled out a red metal container that had cannabis inside of it, and a blue glass pipe with burnt cannabis inside of it. I stated to Sean, I thought you said that there was no cannabis in the vehicle. Sean stated he did not smoke cannabis in the vehicle. I advised Sean that I was going to search his vehicle. I asked Sean to remove his dog from the vehicle. Sean removed his dog and stood with Sgt. Bauer at the front of my squad car.

I began to search the vehicle and found the following items in the vehicle.

Black container with 2 plastic baggies with methamphetamine inside of them, glass pipe, and a black scale located in the back seat in a travel hygiene bag.

First plastic baggie field tested positive for methamphetamine and was weighed in the baggie 1.13 grams. Second baggie weighed 0.50 grams.

Glass pipe had white and black residue in it, commonly used to smoke methamphetamine.

Black scale had white residue on it, as if it was used to weigh methamphetamine.

1 plastic baggie with cannabis inside of it located in the back seat.

I advised Sean that he was under arrest for possession of methamphetamine. I placed Sean in handcuffs, double locked and checked for fit. I placed Sean in the back seat of my squad car. I secured all of the items located in the vehicle in evidence baggies that were later logged into evidence and placed into temporary evidence locker #6. I requested first available towing service through Logan Dispatch. Logan Dispatch advised that Ron's Towing Service was in route to my location. I completed searching the vehicle and did not locate any other contraband in the vehicle. Ron's Towing arrived and took possession of Sean's vehicle.

I transported Sean to the Logan County Jail. I completed my paperwork for Sean, and released him to Jail staff with no other incident. Sean was arrested for Possession of methamphetamine under 5 grams, and Possession of drug paraphernalia. Sean was issued the following citations.

Citation #228108 for not wearing a seatbelt.

Civil Citation #00929 for possession of cannabis and drug paraphernalia in motor vehicle.

Written warning #28759 for obstructed registration.

Sean was issued his copies of citations and remained in the custody of Jail staff. At the Logan County Safety Complex, I took photographs of the evidence collected at the scene and uploaded them to this report. I uploaded my in car video and audio to a DVD to be logged into evidence. I cloud shared my in-car video and audio to the SA Office. I uploaded copies of citations and paperwork to this report.
