Dep Grayson Narrative

On 07/15/22 at approximately 0644 hours, Logan Dispatch received a call from David Schnieder stating that a truck and two individuals were trespassing, and camping on his property off of [REDACTED]. David stated that he would like them removed from his property. David's address was [REDACTED] and stated they were straight west from his house. I located the property in the 1300 block of 2100 St. The truck was located approximately 200 yards south off of 2100 St between cornfields and Kickapoo Creek. I arrived on scene at approximately 0700 hours.

I observed a tan Chevrolet truck parked between two trees with a tent in front of the vehicle. I approached the vehicle and observed a female in the driver seat appeared to be asleep. I observed a male to be in the passenger seat that appeared to be asleep. I looked into the vehicle and on the females lap, I observed a clear plastic baggie with white/yellowish substance inside of it. From my training and experience, I believed this to be narcotics. I also observed an open pill bottle that appeared to be empty on Jennifer's lap. I observed there to be a rubber pipe in the cup holder. I looked at the female and could not observe her chest to rise, I was not sure if the female was breathing. I knocked on the window multiple times and no response. I was worried the female had overdosed. I opened the driver side door and began to shake the females left shoulder. After a few moments the female responded. I announced myself as Logan County Sheriff's Office, Deputy Grayson. The female driver who later identified as Jennifer Pozsgai opened her eyes and started to speak. The male passenger, later identified David Graham, woke up as I announced myself.

I asked Jennifer and David to get out of the vehicle. I advised Jennifer and David that the owner of the property did not want them out here anymore and were verbally trespassed from the property. I asked David and Jennifer who the drugs in the vehicle belonged to. David and Jennifer would not speak. David stated that the white yellowish substance was his, David stated he put it on Jennifer's lap. I advised Jennifer and David that they were both under arrest. I placed David and Jennifer in handcuffs, double locked and checked for fit. I read Jennifer and David their Miranda Rights, and placed Jennifer in the back seat of my squad car. Dep. Maslanka arrived on scene shortly after reading Miranda Rights. I placed David in the back seat of Dep. Maslanka squad car. I requested the first available towing service through Logan Dispatch. Logan Dispatch advised Ron's Towing Service was in route to my location.

I started to search the vehicle with Dep. Maslanka. The following items were located in the vehicle.

*1 clear glass smoking device with black substance in it. Located in the driver side door.

*1 blue glass smoking device with white/brown substance in it. Located on the passenger floorboard with 1 OZ of water in it that was collected due to methamphetamine being smoked through the water.

*1 clear plastic baggie with white/yellowish substance that field tested positive for crack cocaine and weighed 3 grams. Located on Jennifer's lap.

*1 orange pill bottle with white crystal substance that field tested positive for methamphetamine and weighed 2 grams. Located in Jennifer's purse in a makeup bag.

*1 gray pill bottle with white crystal substance in it that field tested positive for methamphetamine and weighed .5 grams. Located with the orange pill bottle in Jennifer's purse.

*1 clear glass smoking device with small amounts of white residue. Located under the Driver seat.

* 2 rubber smoking devices with black residue inside of them unknown substance inside of them. (Later was told by David and Jennifer it was a combination of nicotine/cannabis/narcotics). Located in a black box under the driver seat.

*1 plastic baggie with black/brown substance. Jennifer and David stated it was a combination of things such as nicotine, cannabis, and narcotics. The substance will be sent to ISP Crime Lab for further testing. Located under the driver seat in a black box.

I completed searching the vehicle and did not find any other drug contraband or weapons. I collected all of the evidence located in the vehicle and placed them in to evidence bags. I secured the evidence in the trunk of my squad car.

While searching the vehicle, I observed a pouch of jewelry, I found this odd due to most of it being gold. Jennifer and David stated that they were kicked out of their house and that they had no money. I believed that this property could possibly been stolen.

Ron's Towing Service arrived on scene. I completed my Towing paper work and advised Ron's Towing that the truck was full of personal belongings. I stated the truck had clothing, tools, jewelry, and lawn equipment. Ron's Towing stated they would put it in the lot that it fully gated and secured. Ron's Towing took possession of the truck. I transported Jennifer to Logan County Jail. Dep. Maslanka transported David to Logan County Jail. Jennifer and David were released to Jail staff with no incident.

Both Jennifer and David were interviewed by Inspector Mayes and myself. Before the interviews began, separately, Inspector Mayes advised both individuals they were not under Miranda, and their statements could not be used against them. During the interview with David, Inspector Mayes told David that he knew David was involved in burglaries in Lincoln IL. Inspector Mayes asked David if stolen items were begin traded for drugs. David stated that he was trading / selling them at Johnny's Buy Trade and Sell Store. To confirm the statement, Inspector Mayes obtained a record from Johnny's Buy Trade and Sell store. Several items had been sold / traded to Johnny's, by David. David confirmed that a men's gold ring had been stolen from a garage located on N Kankakee St, Lincoln IL. David also stated that he had stolen jewelry inside his truck and residence on Ottawa Street in Lincoln IL. Inspector Mayes advised David that there could be Burglary Investigations being conducted. Inspector Mayes called Detective Reed with

Lincoln Police Department and informed him of David's statement which had been directed that he was not under Miranda and that his statements would not be used against him since the interview was for narcotic intelligence. Detective Reed arrived to Logan County Complex to speak with David.

Detective Reed interviewed David, see Detective Reed's report. David admitted to Detective Reed about the stolen men's ring. However, David did not give any more information including that there was not stolen property inside the truck nor in his residence on Ottawa Street in Lincoln IL.

After the interview with Detective Reed, Inspector Mayes and I went back into the interview room. David stated he had gotten scared while talking to the Detective because he thought the Detective was going to arrest him. David stated to me that he would still be willing to hand over the stolen property with hopes of cooperation with the State's Attorney's Office. I later took David to his vehicle at Ron's towing lot to recover the stolen property. David handed me a black wrist watch, a female silver ring with blue stone in it, and a silver female necklace. David stated he had more stolen property at the house. I took David to [REDACTED] David handed me two silver female's necklaces. I collected the stolen property to be logged into evidence. I forwarded pictures to Detective Reed to attempt to locate the owners of the property.

I logged and placed all the evidence collected from the vehicle in to temporary evidence locker #6. I collected the jewelry and logged it into evidence placed it into temporary evidence locker #6. I collected pictures of all of the evidence and uploaded it to a CD that was logged into evidence. I uploaded my in car camera audio and video to a DVD and logged it into evidence. I cloud shared a copy of my in car camera to the States Attorney's Office.
