#### **Dep Grayson Narrative**

On 07/16/22 at approximately 0814 hours, I was patrolling west on 1550th ST approaching 100 Ave. I came to a stop at 1550th St and 100 Ave, I observed vehicle tire marks going into the ditch on the northwest side of the road on 1550th St. I crossed 100 Ave and approached the tire marks. I observed there to be corn knocked down that was as wide as a vehicle. It appeared to me that a vehicle went off the roadway and went into the cornfield.

I exited my vehicle and walked into the cornfield to see if a vehicle was still in the field. I followed the tracks and approximately 50 yards northwest. I observed 4-5 rows of corn to be knocked down. It appeared the vehicle went into the cornfield approximately 30 yards, turned around and drove 20 yards out completing a u turn. The vehicle exited the corn and pulled back on to 1550th St headed eastbound. I believed the vehicle pulled back on to 100 Ave and traveled southbound. I collected pictures of the cornfield and the rows of corn that was knocked down, and tire tracks from the vehicle. I uploaded the photos to a CD that was logged into evidence.

I will attempt to contact the owner of the field to make them aware of the criminal damage to their property.

On 07/20/22 at approximately 0630 hours, I contacted Rodney Conklen, who farms the field that was damaged. Rodney stated that if we did not know who did it or had not caught the person who damaged the cornfield then there was not much he would do or could do. Rodney stated that it would cost more to file an insurance claim then what the corn was worth that was damaged. I advised Rodney that if he needed a police report, that I had one completed that he could pick up.
