Dep. Grayson Narrative

The following narrative, not verbatim nor in its entirety, is a summary of my observations, investigations and actions in the arrest of Dustin Pitts **and the second secon**

On 09/04/2022 at approximately 1922 hours, I, Dep. Grayson was traveling South on N Kickapoo St near Broadway St, in Lincoln IL. I observed a green Dodge Dakota traveling East on Broadway St. I observed the male driver not wearing a seatbelt. The Dodge was bearing Illinois Registration: registered to Dustin and Angela Pitts.

I initiated a traffic stop on the green Dodge truck. We came to a stop at Broadway St and N. Sheridan St. I made contact with the driver, identified to be Dustin Pitts. I advised Dustin that I observed him not wearing a seatbelt when he passed by me. Dustin stated that he did not have a seatbelt on and put it on after I pulled behind him. Dustin provided me with an Illinois Driver's License and valid proof of insurance on the vehicle. I asked Dustin to come back to my squad car to speak with me. While speaking with Dustin in my squad car I could smell an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from Dustin's person.

I asked Dustin where he was coming from. Dustin stated he was at Dottie's. I asked Dustin if Dottie's served alcohol. Dustin stated they did. I asked Dustin how many drinks he had tonight. Dustin stated he had 2 drinks, then stated he had 4. I asked Dustin what time he started drinking, he stated 5 p.m. I asked Dustin what time he left Dottie's. Dustin stated 7 p.m. I asked Dustin how many drinks an hour he had. Dustin stated 1 beer for every hour he was there. I advised Dustin if he had 4 beers, he would have had to been there longer than 2 hours. Dustin stated he had 2 beers for each hour he was there.

I requested Dustin to step out of the vehicle for Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFSTs). I explained and demonstrated the following SFSTs.

HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS (HGN):

On HGN, I asked Dustin to place his feet together and arms down to his side. I asked Dustin if he had any problems or abnormalities with his eyes. Dustin stated that he did not. I instructed Dustin that I wanted him to follow my stimulus with his eyes, and his eyes only. I told Dustin that I did not want him to move his head. Dustin stated that he understood the instructions.

While administering HGN, I observed the following;

Dustin was moving his head side to side. I told Dustin on multiple occasions to keep his head straight and to use his eyes only.

Dustin had lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes. I observed Dustin's eyes to jerk back and forth.

Dustin had distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation

Onset prior to 45 degrees. Dustin could not hold his eyes at maximum deviation. Dustin would stare at me, and I would advise Dustin to look at the stimulus.

I observed (6) clues out of a criteria of (4) four or more.

WALK AND TURN (WAT):

On WAT, I instructed Dustin to place his right foot in front of his left foot and to keep his arms down to his side. I told Dustin that I wanted him to stay in that position while I explained and demonstrated the test. I then explained and demonstrated the test. I asked Dustin if he has any problems or abnormalities with his legs, or any problems that would keep him from taking (9) nine steps down, making a proper turn, and taking (9) nine steps back. Dustin stated that he did not have any problems. I asked Dustin if he understood the test, he stated that he did.

While Dustin performed WAT, I observed the following clues; Cannot keep balance while listening to instructions Steps off the line Uses arms to balance

I observed (3) clues out of a criteria of (2) two or more.

ONE LEG STAND (OLS):

On OLS, I had Dustin place his feet together and arms down to his side. I explained to Dustin that when instructed, I wanted him to lift one foot (foot of his choice) approximately (6) six inches off of the ground, hold it parallel with the ground and count in the manner that I instruct. I told Dustin that I wanted him to look at his foot while performing the test. I told Dustin that the test would take (30)

thirty seconds.

While Dustin performed OLS, I observed the following clues; Dustin asked what foot to raise. I advised Dustin to pick a foot and continue the test. Sways while balancing Uses arms to balance Puts foot down

I observed (3) clues out of a criteria of (2) two or more.

Due to the totality of clues that Dustin produced on SFSTs, I asked him if he would give a breath sample into a Preliminary Breath Test (PBT). Dustin gave a PBT sample of .101. I told Dustin that he was under arrest for DUI. I placed handcuffs on Dustin, checked for fit, and double locked them. I searched Dustin for weapons and contraband, I did not locate any on Dustin's person. Dustin was then placed in the rear seat of my patrol car. I then requested Logan Dispatch to contact first available towing service to my location to take possession of the Dodge Dakota, with a hold for (12) hour DUI. I transported Dustin to the Logan County Jail.

Dep Lasanska stayed with the vehicle until Ron's Towing arrived on scene. Ron's Towing Service arrived on scene shortly after, and took possession of the vehicle.

The twenty minute observation period began at 2001 hours. The Warning to Motorist was read to Dustin at 2006 hours. I requested Dustin to give a breath sample. Dep. Lasanska arrived at the complex to administer the breathalyzer test. At 2024 hours, Dustin gave a sample of .098. I then advised Dustin of the Law Enforcement Sworn Report. It should be noted that the time on the Logan County breathalyzer machine was 7 minutes off. Dustin provided a breath sample at 2024 hours, and the ticket stated 2031 hours. Dustin was issued the following Illinois Uniform Citations, with a notice to appear in court on 11-7-22 at 0900 hours. Citation Number:228274 for no seatbelt Citation Number:228275 for A (2) - .098

Dustin was provided with copies of the Illinois Uniform Citations, Warning to Motorist and Law Enforcement Sworn Report.

Dustin was released to jail staff and booked on the following charges; Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol
