Dep. Grayson Narrative

On 10/01/22 at approximately 2159 hours, Logan Dispatch received a call from Ashley Martinez [REDACTED], stating her [REDACTED], had ran away at approximately 2030 hours. I arrived on scene to speak with Ashely. Ashely stated around 2100 hours she found a note [REDACTED] had left for her in [REDACTED] room. Ashley showed me the note, it stated "I can't take this anymore", "do not try to find me". Ashley did not believe [REDACTED] was suicidal, but stated [REDACTED] has had behavioral issues lately. Ashley stated that on her ring doorbell camera, she observed [REDACTED] walk out of the house and come back into the house. Shortly after her husband went out to his car and came back into the house and [REDACTED] was gone.

I asked Ashley if she could provide a most recent picture of [REDACTED] Ashley provided a picture, and what [REDACTED] was wearing when [REDACTED] left the house. Ashely stated [REDACTED] was in a black coat with a dark gray t-shirt, blue jeans, and black and white Adidas shoes. Ashley stated [REDACTED] black BMX bicycle was gone, and believed [REDACTED] took it when [REDACTED] left. I asked Ashley if [REDACTED] had any friends close by. Ashley stated [REDACTED] did not and was kind of a loner. Ashley stated they recently took [REDACTED] to the doctor for a mental evaluation due to [REDACTED] feeling depressed.

Cpl. Becker arrived on scene. We patrolled San Jose IL, and could not locate [REDACTED] Cpl. Becker spoke with Mason County to have them be on the lookout for [REDACTED] Cpl. Becker gave Logan Dispatch [REDACTED] information and photograph to enter [REDACTED] into LEADS as a runaway. Cpl. Becker and I continued to search the area, local county roads, and nearby towns in attempt to locate [REDACTED] but were not able to locate [REDACTED]

Cpl. Becker advised the parents to call Logan County, if [REDACTED] returns home before we are able to locate [REDACTED] to take [REDACTED] out of LEADS.
