## EVIDENCE OF CELLULAR PHONES

On October 13th, 2022, I took Chelsey Lowe's Cellular phone described as Black, with black case, Samsung, IMEI: [REDACTED] from CID CIEG Locker #5. I also obtained George Wisheart's cellular phone described as black and green iridescent color, with black case, Motorola Cellular phone from CID CIEG Locker #5.

I transferred custody of these two phones from the Logan County Safety Complex in Lincoln IL. to the Central Illinois Enforcement Group (CIEG) Office in Springfield IL. I then executed the search warrant for the phones, in which I had obtained on October 11th, 2022. The phones data were then downloaded onto a Terra Hard Drive by Analyst Alex Biermann. Once that was completed, I took the cellular phones and the Terra Hard Drive and drove back to the Logan County Safety Complex. I placed the cellular phones back into CID CIEG Locker #5. I then downloaded the data from Chelsey Lowe's cellular phone from the Terra Drive onto a DVD. The DVD was then placed into Locker #5. I then downloaded the data from George Wisheart's cellular phone from the terra drive onto a DVD. The DVD was then placed into Locker #5.

## EVIDENCE OF SECURITY FOOTAGE OF SHELL GAS STATION

On October 19th, 2022, I met with Shell Manager, Bonnie Taylor, at the Shell Station located at 2770 W. Washington Street in Springfield IL. Taylor had downloaded the Shell Station Security Footage from the Shell Station located at 3300 Clearlake from the dates of October 2nd, 2022, 2230 hours to October 3rd, 2022, 0130 hours. Taylor gave me the thumb drive containing the security footage.

I then returned to the Logan County Safety Complex and downloaded copies of the Security Footage onto DVD's. The original thumb drive of the security Footage was then placed into CID CIEG Locker #4.

## REVIEWING CELLULAR PHONE DATA

I then reviewed the cellular phone data belonging to Chelsey Lowe. I also reviewed the cellular phone data belonging to George Wisheart. The following is a summary of that review:

Chelsey Lowe data extraction showed the phone number to her cellular phone is [REDACTED]. Chelsey Lowe's call log showed incoming and outgoing calls from October 2nd, 2022, at approximately 1854 hours to 0105 hours on October 3rd, 2022, to telephone number [REDACTED]. The telephone number [REDACTED] belongs to George Wisheart. In her contact information, Chelsey has the name Soulmate with telephone number [REDACTED].

Chelsey Lowe's text message log showed text messages between telephone number [REDACTED] (believed to be Cody Wells) and George Wisheart between October 2nd, 2022, 2000 hours, and October 2nd, 2329 hours. The text messages show that Chelsey Lowe and George Wisheart are trying to meet Cody Wells and purchase narcotics.

Chelsey Lowe also has pictures on her phone of narcotics and a message indicating that they were going to sell narcotics to someone but did not have a date.

George Wisheart data extraction showed the phone number to his cellular phone is [REDACTED]. George Wisheart call log showed incoming and outgoing calls from October 2nd, 2022, at approximately 0258 hours to October 2nd, 2022, at approximately 2353 hours to telephone numbers [REDACTED] (Michelle Eddy), [REDACTED] (Wes), [REDACTED] (Cody Wells), and [REDACTED] (Chelsey Lowe).

George Wisheart contact information showed that phone number [REDACTED] belonged to Michelle Eddy, phone number [REDACTED] belonged to Wes, phone number [REDACTED] belonged to Cody W., and phone number [REDACTED] belonged to Baby Girl.

George Wisheart text message information showed text messages between telephone number [REDACTED] (Cody Wells) and [REDACTED] (Chelsey Lowe) between 0249 hours on October 2nd, 2022, and 0112 hours on October 3rd, 2022. The text messages show that George Wisheart and Chelsey Lowe are trying to meet Cody Wells and purchase narcotics. Earlier texts before this shows that other people are asking for narcotics from George Wisheart.

George Wisheart also has pictures on his phone of suspected narcotics being weighed on a digital scale, a black magnetic box containing suspected narcotics (remarkably like the black magnetic box that was found on the traffic stop), and suspected Ice Methamphetamine being weighed on a digital scale, see below text message obtained from data extraction on George Wisheart's cellular phone.

#### REVIEWING SHELL STATION SECURITY FOOTAGE

On October 19th, 2022, at approximately 1000 hours, Dep. Grayson and I reviewed camera footage obtained from the Shell gas station located at 3300 E. Clear Lake Ave in Springfield IL. During the review of the camera footage, Dep. Grayson and I observed the

following things from the multiple camera views:

At approximately 2249 hours, the security video revealed an orange SUV bearing Illinois registration [REDACTED] drive into the gas station lot to pump #3. A later computer search revealed this registered to Debbie Philips at [REDACTED]. Through a computer search, a Dawn Philips also lived at [REDACTED]. Later, Dep. Grayson was able to utilize social media and link Dawn Philips to Cody Wells. This was the vehicle known to be driven by Cody Wells from [REDACTED] through the investigation.

At approximately 2250 hours, a white male (Cody Wells) was observed getting out of the driver seat of the vehicle. Another white male got out of the front passenger seat who is believed to be Dawn Phillips's son. Later, Dep. Grayson was able to identify him through Dawn's social media. He exited the vehicle and walked into the gas station. The white male believed to be Cody Wells was observed going to the rear of the vehicle and laid down on the ground to get under the vehicle. Approximately 2251 hours, the white male (Cody Wells) was observed getting off the ground and going to the back passenger door of the vehicle. The white male then removed his white shirt. The white male (Cody Wells) went back to the rear of the vehicle and got back on the ground.

At approximately 2252 hours, the other white male (Dawn's son) walked out of the gas station back to the vehicle. Then walked back to the trunk of the vehicle and opened the trunk.

At approximately 2254 hours, the white male (Cody Wells) put his white t-shirt back on and walked to the driver's door. The white male (Cody Wells) walked back to the trunk and closed the trunk to the vehicle. The white male (Cody Wells) got on to his cell phone and sat in the driver seat of the vehicle.

At approximately 2258 hours, the white male (Cody Wells) and the other white male (Dawn's son) leave the gas station in the orange SUV.

At approximately 2304 hours, a blue Chevy Lumina owned by Michele Eddings pulled into the Shell gas station parking lot. This was the vehicle that George Wisheart, Chelsey Lowe, and Michele Eddings were known to be in through the investigation.

At approximately 0017 hours, the white male (Cody Wells) in the orange SUV arrived at the shell gas station and pulled up to Pump #1. As the vehicle parked, the other white male (Dawn's son) was now in the back passenger seat with a white female later identified as (Dawn Philips). George Wisheart was now in the front passenger seat.

At approximately 0018 hours, the white female (Dawn Philips) and the other white male (Dawn's son) exited the vehicle and walked into the gas station.

At approximately 0019 hours, Wisheart exited the passenger seat of the orange SUV. The white male (Cody Wells) exited the vehicle with Wisheart. Wisheart walked away from the orange SUV. Wisheart walked back to the blue Lumina.

At approximately 0020 hours, Wisheart walked towards the blue Chevy Lumina. At approximately 0021 hours, Wisheart exited the blue Chevy Lumina and walked towards the orange SUV.

At approximately 0021 hours, Wisheart walked away from the blue Lumina and walked back to the orange SUV. Wisheart leaned into the passenger seat of the orange SUV.

At approximately 0022 hours, the white female (Dawn Philips) and the other white male (Dawn's son) walked out of the gas station and got into the back passenger seats of the orange SUV.

At 0025 hours, Wisheart stopped leaning into the passenger seat of the orange SUV. Wisheart exited the vehicle with a small black bag in his right hand. The white female (Dawn Phillips) exited the back passenger seat and got into the front passenger seat. Wisheart walked back to blue Lumina.

At approximately 0029 hours, the orange SUV left the Shell gas station. The blue Lumina driven by Chelsey Lowe drove to pump #1 where the orange SUV was parked.

At approximately 0030 hours, Lowe exited the driver seat of the blue Lumina.

At approximately 0031 hours, Lowe, Wisheart and Michelle Eddy exited the vehicle. The trunk of the Lumina was opened.

At approximately 0032 hours, Wisheart walked into the shell gas station.

At approximately 0033 hours, Lowe and Eddy are observed looking down at the ground where the orange SUV was parked. They bent down as if they were picking items up off the ground.

At approximately 0034 hours, Eddy was observed putting something into the trunk of the blue Lumina. Lowe walked into the gas station. Lowe walked in and out of the gas station multiple times between 0034 hours, and 0042 hours. Lowe at one point took light green and black clothes in with her to the gas station but never changed clothes.

At approximately 0035 hours, Wishart walked out of the gas station and went to the trunk of the vehicle with Eddy. Eddy closed the trunk door.

At approximately 0042 hours, Eddy got into the driver seat and drove away from the gas pump up to the building. As Eddy pulled up to the gas station, Lowe walked out of the gas station and got into the back passenger seat of the blue Lumina. The vehicle shortly after left the gas station.

## **Dep. Grayson Narrative**

On 10/03/22 at approximately 0210 hours, I was patrolling east on Keokuk St, approaching Thornton's Gas Station. I observed there to be a blue vehicle parked on the south side of the parking lot behind the building. I passed by the vehicle and observed the front two passengers to look over at me with wide eyes and open mouths as if they were scared. I observed the back passenger to look at me and slide down in the seat as if trying to hide from me. I continued eastbound through the parking lot and parked on the east side of Logan St. I observed the vehicle to leave Thornton's pulling on to Keokuk St. I pulled behind the vehicle on Logan St. The vehicle turned on Tremont St, approaching the intersection of Tremont St. and N. Kickapoo St. I observed a blue Chevy Lumina with Illinois

registration [REDACTED] registered to Michele Eddings, fail to signal 100 feet prior to turning. The vehicle came to a stop at the stop sign at the intersection, turned on a left turn signal, and then turned northbound on to N. Kickapoo St, off of Tremont St. I activated my emergency lights and initiated a traffic stop. We came to a stop at the intersection of Tremont St. and N. Kickapoo St.

I approached the passenger side of the vehicle, I advised the female driver later identified as Michele Eddy I initiated a traffic stop for failure to signal 100 feet prior to turning. I asked Michele for her license and proof of insurance. Michele provided me with her license, and stated she will attempt to pull her insurance up on her phone. I asked the male passenger for his information who identified as George Wischart. George provided his information. Michele asked George to open the glove box to look for her insurance. George opened the glove box, I looked into the glove box and observed a glass jar with a small amount of white crystal substance. I observed George attempt to cover the glass jar up. I asked Michele to step out of the car and bring her phone with her to my squad car to speak with me. As I was walking around the trunk of the vehicle I observed the back female passenger, turn her back towards the window as if to stretch her body out. The back female later identified as Chelsey Lowe. Michele exited the vehicle and came back to my squad car. Officer Kink with the Lincoln Police Department arrived on scene.

Michele got into the passenger seat of my squad car. I asked Michele where she was coming from. Michele stated she was coming from Springfield IL. I asked Michele what she did while in Springfield. Michele began to speak in a fast manner stating "we went to the mall, than to sight see then went to dinner, and then just drove around. All of this was said within one breath. I advised Michele that she provided me with a lot of information in a short time frame. Michele apologized and stated that she just talks fast. I asked Michele what time she had arrived in Springfield. Michele stated she did not know when she got to Springfield, and stated that it was sometime in the afternoon. I asked Michele again what she did while she was in Springfield. Michele stated that they went to eat, than her car broke down and would not start. Michele stated that her car broke down at Circle K gas station on Sangamon Ave in Springfield IL. I found this second statement odd due to Michele changing her stories and events in such a short time span. I asked Michele who her back passenger was. Michele stated her name was Chelsey. I asked Michele how she knew Chelsey, and George. Michele stated they were all friends and were from Champaign IL.

While speaking with Michele in my vehicle, I observed Chelsey to stick her left arm out the window and began to wave it. I exited my vehicle and walked up to the back driver passenger window. I asked Chelsey what she needed. Chelsey stated that I needed to tell Michele her son went to the bathroom on himself and they needed to leave soon to take care of that. I advised Chelsey that I would let Michele know. I asked George and Chelsey where they were coming from. They replied that they were coming from Springfield. I asked them what they did in Springfield. George and Chelsey stated that they were just riding with Michele. They stated Michele needed to go for a ride, and Michele wanted to go to her friend's house in Springfield. I asked who Michele's friend was they stated they did not know.

I went back to my squad car to run Michele's, George's, and Chelsey's information. Michele came back clear and valid. George came back clear and valid. Chelsey was clear and valid. I asked Michele what time she left the mall in Springfield. Michele stated they left the mall a couple 2-3 hours ago. I found this statement odd due to it being 0200 hours in the morning. I know the Springfield mall to close at 1800 hours on Sunday. I asked Michele where she went after the mall, she stated that she went to the gas station due to her son going to the bathroom on himself. I asked Michele if she saw anyone or visited anyone in Springfield. Michele stated no that she never saw anyone else except who was in the vehicle. Michele stated that she never went into the Shell Gas station, but later stated that she went into the shell gas station to clean her son up.

I asked Michele if there was any drug contraband or weapons in the vehicle. Michele stated there was cannabis in the vehicle, and stated that she had a glass pipe in her pocket. Michele stated there was cannabis in the middle console of her vehicle. Michele stated that if there was anything in the vehicle she did not know about it. I advised Michele that I was going to search her vehicle. Michele started to talk over me as if she was trying to plead her case about not knowing what was in the vehicle. Michele stated she only knew about her cannabis. I advised Michele I observed a glass bottle in the glove box with white crystal substance in it. Michele began to cry and stating she did not know about anything in the vehicle. I found these actions to be odd as if she had been caught or knew she was going to be in trouble, and distance herself from her passengers. I asked Michele if there was anything in the vehicle that she took her passengers to pick up. As I was asking her questions Michele began to shake her head side to side and kept repeating nope as if she wasn't even listening to me.

I asked Michele to exit my squad car so I could search her for other drug contraband. Michele while at the front of my squad car, began stating that she was scared for me to search her car, due to her not knowing what I would find in her car. Michele stated she did not know what was in George or Chelsey bags. I advised Michele that if she was with Chelsey and George all night than she should know what they had on their person, bought, or had picked up. Michele stated she did not know what was inside their bags. I searched Michele person and removed a glass pipe that had cannabis inside of it from her coat pocket. I secured the glass pipe on the hood of my squad car. I did not locate any weapons or any other drug contraband on her person. I had Michele get back into the front passenger seat of my squad car. Michele asked if her son could come sit with her in my squad car. I advised Michele that was fine. I went to the car and asked Michele's son Chase Roby to come back with me. I placed Chase in the front passenger seat with Michele. Dep. Lasanska arrived on scene.

I approached the vehicle and asked Chelsey to exit the vehicle. I asked Michele if she could shake her shirt and bra out for me to check for weapons and drug contraband. I did not locate any weapons or drug contraband at this time. I asked Chelsey to sit on the front of my squad car. I asked Chelsey if there was going to be any narcotics in the vehicle. Chelsey stated "nope there is probably some weed". I asked Chelsey I knew about the cannabis but there is not going to be any narcotics in the vehicle. Chelsey stated "no no nothing in the vehicle".

I approached the vehicle and asked George to exit the vehicle. I asked George to exit the vehicle and speak with Officer Kink. Officer Kink had George empty his pockets. While Officer Kink was emptying George's pocket I searched the immediate area of the front passenger seat where George was at. I opened the glove box and located a clear plastic baggie with 4 green pills that appeared to look like [REDACTED] bars inside of it, and a glass jar with white crystal residue inside of it. Shoved in between the Passenger seat and middle console was a gray scale. I exited the vehicle and advised Officer Kink to secure George in handcuffs. Officer Kink secured George in

handcuffs, double locked and checked for fit. I secured Chelsey in handcuffs, double locked and checked for fit. Officer Kink secured George in the back seat of his squad car. Dep. Lasanska secured Chelsey in the back seat of his squad car. I advised Michele that her and her son needed to stay in the front seat of my squad car, while I searched the vehicle. Dep. Lasanska, Officer Kink, and I searched the vehicle.

While searching the vehicle I located the following items.

- \*1 clear plastic corner baggie with 4 green pills with S 90 3 imprinted on the pill. The pill was identified as [REDACTED] 2 Mg [REDACTED] drug class. The pills were located in the glove box.
- \* 1 glass jar with white crystal residue in it, located in the glove box.
- \* 1 gray scale that was located between the passenger seat and the middle console.
- \* A metal realistic pellet handgun that was next to the scale stuck between the passenger seat and middle console. George stated the pellet handgun was his.
- \* Multiple clear plastic baggies, located inside a small black bag that was under the passenger seat. George's credit card and debit cards were located in the small black bag.
- \* Black scale that had white substance covering the scale. Located with clear plastic baggies.
- \* 2 metal containers one black and one silver with white crystal residue in both containers, located in George's book bag in the trunk of the vehicle. George claimed the book bag to be his.
- \* 1 black magnetic lockbox with a melted substance inside that field tested positive for Methamphetamine.

I read George his Miranda rights, George stated he understood his rights. I spoke with George about the pellet gun. I asked George why he was carrying the pellet gun with him. George stated that the pellet gun looked cool, and stated that he always is carrying it with him. I asked George if he uses it as or protection or what. George stated that he uses it in ways that he shouldn't and has been told one day he is going to get shot for it. I advised George that he shouldn't not point it at anyone or use it in an illegal manner due to it looking realistic. I advised George that no one would be able to tell the difference between the pellet gun and a real gun. I asked George about the methamphetamine and scales in his black bag. George stated they were old and from April of this year. I asked George why they were from April. George stated that in April he got in trouble in Piatt County IL, for possession of methamphetamine with intent to deliver. George stated that he struggles with addiction. I asked George what his drug of choice was he stated methamphetamine. George stated that he came down to this area to pick up methamphetamine. I asked George how much he was going to pick up. He stated he did not know. George stated that Michele was driving to this area to pick up methamphetamine to. George stated they were all coming here to pick enough up to get high. I placed George back into the squad car.

I completed searching the vehicle and did not locate any other weapons or drug contraband. Lt. Block arrived on scene shortly after I requested Cpl. Carr, Lincoln Police Department Officer on scene. I advised Cpl. Carr that I believed Michele to possibly be under the influence of narcotics. Cpl. Carr advised me to ask Michele to preform field sobriety test, and he would perform the ARIDE (Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement) test for me. I completed my field sobriety test with Michele and had Cpl. Carr take over. Cpl. Carr advised me that he did not believe Michele to be under the influence of narcotics from what he observed. I advised Michele that she would be free to leave from the scene.

I went to Dep. Lasanska squad car and read Chelsey her Miranda Rights. Chelsey stated she understood her rights. I asked Chelsey why they went to Springfield IL, and then drove to Lincoln IL. Chelsey stated that she was just along for the ride. I advised Chelsey what I had found in the vehicle. I advised Chelsey that George was under arrest for possession of methamphetamine and possession of controlled substance. Chelsey stated that she did not know George had any drugs on him tonight. I advised Chelsey that he had scale baggies and small amount of methamphetamine.

I asked Chelsey to exit the squad car and advised her that I was going to let her go. I removed the handcuffs from Chelsey. Chelsey was advised she was free to leave with Michele. Chelsey went to speak with Lt. Block. Dep. Lasanska checked his squad car and advised he found a white crystal substance in his back seat that appeared to be methamphetamine. I placed Chelsey in handcuffs, double locked and checked for fit. Lt. Block collected pictures of evidence. While searching the back seat of Dep. Lasanska squad car, we located a glass vial that had white crystal substance in it that later field tested positive for methamphetamine. The glass vial had approximately 2 grams inside of it. I secured the methamphetamine in an evidence bag and secured it in my squad car. Dep. Lasanska transported Chelsey to the Logan County Jail. See Dep. Lasanska supplemental report.

I removed George from Officer Kink's squad car and placed him in the back seat of my squad car. I transported George to the Logan County Jail. I arrived at the jail and transported George into the sally port of the jail. As I entered the jail, Dep. Lasanska, and Jail staff advised me Chelsey made a statement she had narcotics inside of her or on her person. I asked Chelsey where she had the narcotics, she stated she had a baggie of methamphetamine inside of her vagina. I gave Chelsey a gloved and stated she could attempt to pull it out herself while at the jail. Chelsey went with the female jail staff to the bathroom to attempt to retrieve the baggie of methamphetamine. Chelsey stated that she could not get the baggie out from inside of her. I asked Chelsey if she would give consent for the doctors to retrieve it, or do I need to apply for a body cavity search warrant. Chelsey stated she wanted the baggie out of her, so she would give consent to the doctors. Dep. Lasanska transported Chelsey to Lincoln Memorial Hospital. See Dep. Lasanska supplemental report.

I completed the booking paperwork for George. While George was being booked in, Dep. Lasanska requested me to the hospital. Dep. Lasanska stated that Chelsey had dumped methamphetamine all over the back seat of his squad car. See Dep. Lasanska, and Lt. Block's supplemental report. Lt. Block responded to the hospital. I released George to Jail staff with no incident. George was arrested for possession of methamphetamine, and possession of controlled substance. I cleared from the jail and went to the hospital to meet with Lt. Block and Dep. Lasanska.

I arrived at the hospital. I observed there to be methamphetamine spread across the back seat of Dep. Lasanska squad car, and on the ground outside of the squad car. Lt. Block gave me an evidence bag to give to the doctors, and stated he would take pictures of the methamphetamine and squad car. I went into the hospital and issued the nursing staff a plastic evidence bag. Nursing staff removed a

clear plastic baggie from Chelsey vagina that later field tested positive for methamphetamine and fentanyl. It was later weighed and weighed in the baggie 10 grams. I collected the baggie to be logged into evidence and secured it in my squad car.

I spoke with Chelsey while at the hospital and asked her again what George, Michele, and her why they made the trip to Springfield and Lincoln. Chelsey stated that all three of them were coming to this area to buy methamphetamine from a guy named Cody. Chelsey stated that they bought methamphetamine. I asked how much methamphetamine George and her used to get high. Chelsey stated that their user amount was 3.5 grams. I advised Chelsey that it appeared she had well over that amount. I asked Chelsey what her plans were with the rest of the amount they had. I asked Chelsey if they delivered or gave the rest to family or friends. Chelsey replied with "sharing is caring". Chelsey stated that they give the methamphetamine to about 10-15 people in Bloomington IL. I asked Chelsey if they were going to take it back to Bloomington IL. She stated they were going to. Chelsey stated that Michele was going to take some back with her to Champaign IL area. I asked Chelsey how they use the methamphetamine, due to not finding and glass pipes. Chelsey stated they snort the methamphetamine. I asked Chelsey how much she snorts at a time. Chelsey stated it depends on if she puts the lines out or if George does. Chelsey states "George puts out some big lines" approximately 0.5 grams to a gram big. Chelsey stated those were too much for her and did smaller lines. I asked Chelsey how much they had bought tonight, she stated about an ounce.

I called the Logan County Jail staff to see if George was still in custody at this time to change charges. Jail staff stated that he had just been released and was still in the lobby. I arrived at the Logan County Sheriff office complex. I went into the Lobby and advised George that he was under arrest on new charges. I placed George in handcuffs, double locked and checked for fit. I transported George back into the jail with Jail staff. I advised George that he was being arrested for possession of methamphetamine with intent to deliver. George stated that there was no methamphetamine in the vehicle. I advised him that we recovered a baggie from Chelsey at the hospital, and that she had dumped some in the squad car in attempt to destroy evidence.

I asked George how much methamphetamine he uses. George stated 3.5 grams. I asked George if he delivers or gave methamphetamine to any of his friends. George stated yes that they all share methamphetamine with each other. George stated he didn't have any tonight to share with anyone. I asked George what about the methamphetamine found on Chelsey person, and the methamphetamine at the hospital. George stated that the glass vial was Michele's. The other baggie was Chelsey's and his. I advised George there was more than a user amount recovered at the hospital. I advised George that I was taking his phone to apply for a search warrant. See Inspector Mayes supplemental report. I released George to Jail staff with no incident.

While at the complex securing evidence into temporary evidence locker #4, Dep. Lasanska called Lt. Block and advised him and I that nursing staff located a large amount of methamphetamine on the bed and ground. Lt. Block responded to the hospital with Inspector Mayes. See Lt. Block, Inspector Mayes, and Dep. Lasanska Supplemental reports. Lt. Block advised me that they recovered a large amount of methamphetamine at the hospital. Lt. Block stated Chelsey had another bag that fell and broke open at while receiving medical treatment. Lt. Block, Inspector Mayes, and Dep. Lasanska collected as much as they could from the Hospital. Lt. Block secured the methamphetamine in evidence bags and secured them in his squad car.

Lt. Block arrived at the Logan County Sheriff Office. I helped carry in the evidence collected. I field tested and weighed the methamphetamine collected. It field tested positive for methamphetamine. The approximate weight total for all the methamphetamine collected from Chelsey was 128 grams total. The methamphetamine will be sent off to ISP lab to be further weighed and tested. I secured all evidence into temporary evidence locker #4.

I uploaded pictures of evidence to a CD to be logged into evidence. I uploaded a DVD with Dep. Lasanska and I in car camera audio / video to be logged into evidence. I cloud shared Dep. Lasanska and I in car camera audio / video to the Logan County States Attorney's Office.

Chelsey was arrested for Possession of methamphetamine. Possession of methamphetamine with intent to deliver. Methamphetamine conspiracy. Obstructing Justice destroying evidence.

George was arrested for Possession of methamphetamine. Possession of methamphetamine with intent to deliver. Methamphetamine conspiracy. Possession of controlled substance.

Michele charges were referred to the Logan County States Attorney's Office. The charges referred are, Possession of methamphetamine. Possession of methamphetamine with intent to deliver. Methamphetamine conspiracy.

I had Logan County Dispatch run a criminal history on Chelsey, George, and Michele. Chelsey had on pending intent to deliver methamphetamine charge in Piatt County IL. George had two pending intent to deliver charges in Piatt County IL. Michele had no criminal history. See Criminal history for Chelsey and George.

I called and spoke with DCFS in regards to Michele child being in the vehicle. The intake ID # [REDACTED]

Dep. Grayson.

## LaSanska Supplemental

On 10/3/2022 at approximately 0210 hours Deputy Grayson Conducted a traffic stop and detained Chelsey L. Lowe at approximately 0226 hours. When I arrived, Chelsey was placed in the back left seat of my squad car.

Deputy Grayson later returned to speak with Chelsey while I was sitting in the drivers seat of my squad car. Deputy Grayson removed Chelsey from the back seat and removed the handcuffs that had been applied. Chelsey was then advised she was free to go home. I observed Chelsey walk over to Lieutenant Block, who was on scene and she began to have a conversation with him. I then exited my squad car to make sure no contraband or personal property was left inside my squad car.



While inspecting my back seat I observed multiple small specks of a clear crystal substance that were located where Chelsey was sitting. I suspected the substance to be Methamphetamine do to my Law Enforcement experience. I advised Lieutenant Block to bring Chelsey over to my squad car. I asked Chelsey what the crystal substance was and she stated something to the effect of "I don't know". Lieutenant Block then spoke with Chelsey. Chelsey advised she had stuffed a small glass jar containing Methamphetamine in-between the seat cushion. Lieutenant Block then placed Chelsey in handcuffs and put her back in my squad car. I then transported Chelsey to the Logan County Jail to be booked in.

I arrived at the jail, removed Chelsey from my squad car and spoke with her in the sally port. I asked Chelsey if there was Methamphetamine located anywhere else on her body, Chelsey stated "yes it's inside of me". Correctional Officer Erin Haynes then placed Chelsey in the body scanner. Once the body scan was complete, I advised Officer Haynes to take Chelsey inside the jail and have Chelsey remove the Methamphetamine that was located inside of her. Chelsey was unable to remove the methamphetamine inside of her. I then transported Chelsey to Lincoln Memorial Hospital to have the methamphetamine removed.

While in route to the hospital Chelsey advised that she thought she was peeing. Chelsey then advised she was not peeing but bleeding out of her vagina. I arrived at Lincoln Memorial Hospital at approximately 0423 hours. When I opened my squad car door to remove Chelsey from my back seat, I observed a clear crystal substance and white powder that covered the seat and floorboard where Chelsey was sitting. Chelsey's pants were partially pulled down and her buttocks was exposed. Chelsey stated the bag containing methamphetamine had broken open. I advised Logan Dispatch of my situation and requested another unit to assist. I then transported Chelsey inside where she was immediately treated. One bag containing methamphetamine was removed from Chelsey's vagina.

While standing by with Chelsey at the hospital, the nurses moved her to a different room. When the nurses moved her to the new room, I entered the room she was originally placed in. A nurse was cleaning the utensil used to remove the bag of methamphetamine from Chelsey. I observed multiple chunks of Methamphetamine on Chelsey's bed where she was laying and on her clothes. I also observed multiple small spots of white powder on the floor that was methamphetamine and had been stepped on. I then observed the nurse pick up the pillow that was located on the bed and attempt to remove the pillowcase. When doing so a white bag containing a large amount of methamphetamine fell out from the pillowcase and onto the floor. I advised the nurse to immediately leave the room do to this now being a crime scene. I then exited the room and stood at the entrance of the room to ensure nothing was disturbed. Lieutenant Block later arrived and took over the scene.

## Lieutenant Block Supplemental

On October 3, 2022 at approximately 3:00 am, I started a patrol shift as a shift supervisor. I was contacted by Corporal Hopp, who I was relieving, and was informed Deputy Grayson and other units were on a traffic stop where drug contraband was located and an investigation was continuing. I responded within a few minutes to the intersection of North Kickapoo Street and Tremont Street and met with the other units.

Corporal Hopp briefed me on the detail up to that point. I was told a male was being detained in the back of LPD Officer Kink's squad car and a female, later identified as Chelsey Lowe, was being detained in the back seat of Deputy LaSanska's squad car. Both were detained for possession of controlled substances. Deputy Grayson was conducting further investigation on the driver, a separate female, for DUI purposes. The driver's [REDACTED] was seated in the front seat of Deputy Grayson's squad car until it was determined what was being done with his mother. Deputy Grayson took a moment and came over to me and provided a brief summary of the circumstances as follows:

He observed suspicious activities consistent with criminal activity at the Thornton's gas station. He was able to observe the vehicle leave the Thornton's lot, got behind it and then observed a traffic violation, resulting in the stop. The driver was from Charleston, IL while the two occupants were from Bloomington, IL. Their statements to him were suspicious and included driving across central Illinois from Bloomington, to Champaign, to Springfield and back toward Bloomington to partake in social activities well outside the normal hours of business operations for some of the activities. A Probable Cause search of the vehicle yielded controlled substances and paraphernalia. He was still investigating the contraband and Michelle possibly being DUI for drugs.

Once Deputy Grayson completed the DUI investigation, it was determined she was not under the influence and had no obvious connection to the contraband so she was going to be released from the scene. Deputy Grayson also determined that Chelsey was not immediately connected to the contraband and could be released from the scene. He had her step out of the back of LaSanska's car and removed her handcuffs. I asked if she would be willing to talk to be and she stated she would. I was speaking to her about their connection to Lincoln when I observed Deputy LaSanska get out of his driver's seat, walk back to his rear seat and open the door. He turned his flashlight on and visually scanned the rear seat. He looked over and us and then back to his seat. He then asked if I could bring Chelsey back to his car, which I did.

Deputy LaSanska shined his light on what appeared to be several small, crystalline objects which were consistent with crystal methamphetamine. He asked Chelsey about the substance, what it was and from where it came. She stated she was not sure what it was, but offered to get a scan done to prove she did not have anything on her person. I left Chelsey with Deputy LaSanska, having her sit in the back seat with the door open. I went over to advise Deputy Grayson of what had transpired and returned to Deputy LaSanska's vehicle. I asked Chelsey to where the meth was, if it was in her clothes or inside her person. She stated she didn't have any and I simply responded that I had been doing this a long time and knew it was inside the car somewhere. She pointed behind her. I asked what that meant and she stated it was behind the seat. I had her get out of the car and stand to my side, where LPD Officer Carr was standing. I located a small glass vial with a metal screw lid immediately behind the seat where Chelsey had been seated. Inside the vial were several small pieces of a crystalline substance consistent with methamphetamines. I photographed and collected the vial, which was turned over to Deputy Grayson. I placed Chelsey under arrest, securing her in handcuffs which were checked for fit and double-locked. While arresting her, Chelsey repeatedly said the meth was not hers. I told her that no longer mattered as she was in possession of it. Chelsey requested her phone from Michele's car, which Corporal Hopp obtained. The phone was later seized for evidence and turned over to Investigator Mayes for processing. Deputy LaSanska transported Chelsey to the Logan County Jail.

Several minutes later, Corporal Hopp received a phone call from Deputy LaSanska who advised Chelsey had admitted to having more meth inside her body and he was transporting her to the ER to have the contraband removed by medical staff. I told Corporal Hopp I would go to the ER. Upon his arrival to the ER, Deputy LaSanska communicated via radio that more methamphetamines were on his back seat and some had fallen to the ground when Chelsey was removed from it.

Upon my arrival, I located Deputy LaSanska's car parked outside the ambulance bay. I had pulled in facing the driver's side of his car and when I approached it, I observed several large pieces of suspected meth on the ground outside the rear passenger door. I looked through the rear window and observed a substantial amount of suspected meth on the rear seat. I obtained the key from Deputy LaSanska upon Deputy Grayson's arrival, instructed him to take an evidence bag to the ER staff to secure any contraband removed from Chelsey. I photographed and collected the suspected meth and secured it in my squad car.

I went inside the ER where I met with Deputy Grayson. He had the sealed evidence bag which contained a tied off bag of a white substance and an empty bag which was partially torn and had a small smear of a red blood-like substance on it. There were a few small crystals of meth in the bottom of the evidence bag as well. Deputy Grayson advised the doctor had advised they had flushed Chelsey's cavity to ensure there were no other crystals remaining inside her. The doctor advised Chelsey had to remain under their observation for 24 hours due to her direct contact with the meth. Deputy Grayson and I cleared while Deputy LaSanska remained at the ER.

Approximately an hour later, Deputy LaSanska called me via phone and advised that while moving Chelsey to another room, a large bag of suspected meth fell to the floor from the pillow Chelsey had been using and broke open. I advised him I was en-route and to secure the room until I could get there.

Upon arrival, I was directed to room 9 where I observed a large amount of suspected meth strewn across the floor and a single fold top style plastic baggy lying on the floor. This baggy also contained suspected meth. There were also several larger crystals of suspected meth on the bed. This was the same room Chelsey had been initially taken to and the bag was removed from her inside her. Due to the wide spread amount on the floor, I contacted Chief Deputy Miller and requested he obtain a new hand broom and dust pan so I could collect the evidence. I photographed the room and upon Chief Deputy Miller's arrival, obtained the broom. A field test was conducted on a piece of suspected meth from the floor and it indicated the presence of methamphetamine. I collected the suspected meth from the bed and placed it into a paper evidence bag. I then collected the plastic baggy from the floor and placed it into a paper evidence bag. I then used the new broom and dust pant to sweep the floor and collect the suspected meth into a paper evidence bag. While processing this room, I was notified other suspected meth was located in the hallway and bathroom of the emergency department. These items were collected by Investigator Mayes. Refer to his report for

After clearing from room 9, I was asked to check the room to where Chelsey was transferred after room 9. I was advised Chelsey had undergone hospital decontamination procedures and was now being housed in another room. I checked room 9 and did not observe any meth in the room or on Chelsey's clothes, which were photographed. I cleared from the hospital again, but before leaving the property, I was called back.

Upon entering the ER, I was advised housekeeping found another suspected meth crystal in room 9 under a piece of medical furniture. I photographed and collected the single crystal into a paper evidence bag before clearing the ER again.

I returned to the Logan County Safety Complex where I met with Deputy Grayson. We weighed and field tested the suspected meth. See Deputy Grayson's report for more detail. All evidence was turned over to Deputy Grayson for storage and testing requests. The photographs taken were uploaded to the photo server.

# Mayes Supplemental

## INCIDENT

On October 3rd, 2022, I was contacted by LT. Block in reference to a traffic stop conducted by Deputy Grayson. The traffic stop led to narcotics being found, see original report for more information.

I traveled to the Logan County Safety Complex and observed LT. Block leaving the Complex. I contacted LT. Block who advised there were more narcotics found at the Hospital and asked if I could assist. I advised that I could and drove to the Memorial ER Hospital in Lincoln IL.

Once at the hospital, I contacted LT. Block in person. LT. Block advised that while Chelsey Lowe was at the hospital, she was able to hide a large amount of suspected Ice Methamphetamine that ended up on the floor in exam room 9. I went to exam room 9 with LT. Block. From the entrance room doors, I was able to observe a large plastic bag containing a white crystal substance, and white crystal particles spread out over the floor. From my Law Enforcement experience and Narcotics work, I suspected the substance to be Ice Methamphetamine.

There was a small crystal particle in the hallway. I photographed the particle and collected the particle into a paper evidence bag. I then gave the evidence bag to Lt. Block.

I was later informed that there were more white crystal particles in the bathroom of the ER. I was informed that Chelsey Lowe had been in this bathroom. I went to the bathroom with Deputy Lasanska and observed white crystal particles on the bathroom floor which I suspected to be Ice Methamphetamine. LT Block requested a small brush and pan be purchased at the local Walmart. Chief Deputy N. Miller arrived at the hospital with a newly purchased brush and pan.

I took the brush and pan. Deputy Lasanska took photographs as I brushed the white crystal particles into the pan in the bathroom. I then placed the crystal particles into a paper evidence bag. I then took brush / pan and the evidence bag to LT Block who was collecting other evidence in the hospital, see his report for further details.

## INTERVIEW WITH GEORGE WISEHART

I later returned to the Logan County Safety Complex. I contacted TFO K. Robinson who arrived at the Logan County Safety Complex. At approximately 1500 hours, TFO Robinson and I conducted an interview of George E. Wisehart [REDACTED]. Wisehart had been arrested in the traffic stop with Deputy Grayson for Manufacture/Delivery of Controlled Substance. The following is a summary of the interview. The information given by Wisehart might not be in exact order in which was obtained, and is not verbatim, see the video of the interview for more information.

Wisehart, who was brought into the interview room handcuffed, was taken out of handcuffs before the interview began. Wisehart was also given some water.

I explained to Wisehart that the audio and video was turned on in the interview room. Wisehart said he understood. I introduced myself and TFO Robinson to Wisehart. I explained to Wisehart that I was informed that he had been given Miranda out at the scene of the traffic stop. Wisehart confirmed that he had. I advised Wisehart that he was still under those Miranda Rights at that time. Wisehart confirmed that he understood.

I explained to Wisehart that I was there to see if he wanted to cooperate to help him with his charges. I explained to Wisehart what the charges were. I explained to him that if he cooperated, that I would investigate into seeing if I could help him with his charges in both Logan and Piatt County. Wisehart was told that I could not promise or guarantee anything, only that the information provided would be given to the State's Attorney's for their review. I then would be able to work with the State's Attorney's Office to assist in trying to assist in cooperation with hopes of leniency on the current charges.

I then obtained some personal information from Wisehart. He gave me his name and date of birth. He provided an address of [REDACTED]. He was divorced and has a son who is 19 years of age. He is employed doing odd jobs in maintenance. He was born in [REDACTED]. Wisehart stated he was an addict of methamphetamine. Wisehart stated he also consumes cannabis.

Wisehart stated he was at Chelsey Lowe's mother's house before all this incident occurred. That address is the [REDACTED] in [REDACTED]. Wisehart stated Lowe is his girlfriend who he has been with for years. Wisehart stated he was with his girlfriend at the address. Wisehart stated both he and Lowe were communicating with Cody Wells from Jerseyville about purchasing four ounces of Ice Methamphetamine. Wisehart stated Wells also owed him an ounce. Wisehart stated he and Lowe were texting and calling on their phones with Wells. Wisehart stated they were not going through an app. Wisehart advised they had purchased Ice

Methamphetamine from Wells approximately 3-4 times prior to this incident. The average amount of Ice Methamphetamine purchased was an ounce. Wishart stated Wells was charging \$300 an ounce. Wishart stated they purchased the four ounces for \$1075 last night.

Wishart stated when meeting Wells, Wells would be in different cars. Wishart believed he was renting cars or using cars from other people. Wishart described Wells as brown hair, little chubby, 30ish years old, six feet, approximately two hundred pounds, and scruffy. Wishart stated Wells phone number was in Wishart's phone.

Wishart stated they then called Michelle Eddy to come pick him and Lowe up to give them a ride. Wishart stated Eddy knew that Wishart and Lowe were purchasing Ice Methamphetamine. Wishart stated Eddy was going to get gas money and Methamphetamine for driving them.

Wishart stated Eddy arrived in a blue four door car. Eddy had her [REDACTED] with her. Wishart stated the [REDACTED]. They then left Bloomington.

Wishart stated they were supposed to meet Wells at a rest stop south of Springfield. However, they were skeptical of the meet location and Wells. Wishart stated they stopped at a Circle K just off the interstate in Springfield IL. They called Wells and told him to come to that location. Wishart stated there was a Shell gas station across the street from the Circle K. Wishart stated there was a McDonald's down the road and a U-Haul across the street.

Wishart stated Wells arrived and went to the Shell. Wishart stated Wells drove to Circle K and told Wishart to follow. Wells took them to a small hotel pulling into the back. Wishart stated it was called the Best Rest. Wishart stated when they pulled in, Lowe pulled into a parking spot. Wishart got out and got into the vehicle that Wells came in. Wishart stated Wells had placed the Ice Methamphetamine into a black magnetic box. Wells had placed the box onto the muffler. The muffler melted the box which damaged and melted some of the Ice Methamphetamine. Wells was showing Wishart the box and Ice Methamphetamine when he got into Wells car at the Best Rest.

Wishart stated a vehicle backed out of the back of the Best Rest and Lowe backed up and got back into a parking spot. The vehicle movement got Wells uneasy. So, he left and went to the Shell Station across from the Circle K in which they had just left. Lowe followed. Wishart stated Lowe was upset and they started to get into an argument. Wishart got back in with Wells. Wishart gave Wells the \$1075. Wishart took the box with the Ice Methamphetamine. Wishart believed the amount of Ice Methamphetamine was approximately four ½ ounces. Wishart got out of Wells car. Wishart got into the front passenger seat. Wishart stated some Ice Methamphetamine had fell out onto the concrete at the gas station. Wishart stated Eddy got out and picked up as much Methamphetamine that she could off the ground.

Wishart stated they then drove back towards Bloomington. Wishart stated they went into Lincoln IL because Eddy's son had defecated in his pants.

Wishart stated they left and were getting stopped by the Police. Wishart stated he gave the Ice Methamphetamine to Lowe before they pulled over. Wishart stated Eddy had some Ice Methamphetamine on her prior to getting the Ice Methamphetamine off the ground. She gave that to Lowe prior to stopping for Police.

TFO Robinson and I then started interviewing Wishart on narcotic information he knew in the area, see interview for more information.

At approximately 1610 hours, TFO Robinson and I concluded the interview with Wishart.

#### INTERVIEW WITH CHELSEY LOWE

I returned to the Logan County Safety Complex on October 4th, 2022. I contacted Det. Park and requested his assistance in interviewing Chelsey Lowe. At approximately 0905 hours, Det. Park and I conducted an interview of Chelsey L. Lowe ([REDACTED]). Lowe had been arrested in the traffic stop with Deputy Grayson for Possession with intent to Delivery Methamphetamine. The following is a summary of the interview. The information given by Lowe might not be in exact order in which was obtained, and is not verbatim, see the video of the interview for more information.

I explained to Lowe the interview would be audio and video recorded. Det. Park introduced himself to Lowe. I read Lowe her Miranda Rights. After each right, Lowe stated she understood. I asked Lowe if she understood the rights read to her. Lowe stated she did. I asked Lowe if she would be willing to talk with us. Lowe stated she would.

I explained to Lowe how I could possibly assist her in her narcotics case by getting leniency on current charges with cooperation on potential future narcotic cases.

I then obtained personal information about Lowe. I obtained her name and date of birth. I obtained her address of [REDACTED]. I obtained her phone number of [REDACTED]. Lowe explained she had [REDACTED]. Lowe was on probation in Piatt County for Suspended Driving. Lowe had a pending charge in Piatt County for Delivery of Methamphetamine.

On March 2nd, 2022, before being picked up in Bloomington, Lowe is at her mother's residence in [REDACTED]. Lowe stated Wischart is talking to Cody Wells in Farmersville about purchasing Ice Methamphetamine. Lowe stated Wells does not particularly like her because she is outspoken and direct. Lowe stated Wischart was also trying to get the ounce of Ice Methamphetamine that Wells owed them.

Approximately 2-3 months ago, Lowe reached out to Wells to purchase Ice Methamphetamine. Lowe stated she knew Wells from going to school with him in Leroy IL. Lowe reached out to Wells on Facebook. Lowe stated Wells is from Leroy, but lives in Jerseyville IL. Lowe stated they had purchased Ice methamphetamine from Wells approximately 6-7 times before the incident on the 3rd of October 2022.

Lowe described Wells as a white male, tall, heavier set, brown buzzed hair, no facial hair, driving an orange SUV that belonged to his girlfriend, Dawn. Wells is known to borrow other cars from individuals. Lowe stated in the 6-7 times they purchased Ice methamphetamine from Wells, they have purchased a quarter pound (QP), and around four ounces. Lowe said the cost of those change. Lowe stated they spent \$1075 for the four ounces on the 2nd of October. Lowe stated the more ounces you buy, the cheaper the cost.

Lowe stated when they were in Bloomington, Wischart was texting Wells on a regular line and not through Facebook or an app. Lowe said as they were driving, Wells was texting her on the regular line because Wischart was driving.

Lowe stated after making the deal with Wells, they needed a ride and called Michelle Eddy. Lowe stated Wischart knew Michelle because they grew up together. Lowe stated Wischart called Eddy for the ride. Lowe stated Michelle was going to get gas money and methamphetamine for giving them a ride to purchase Ice Methamphetamine from Wells. Lowe stated Eddy lived in Charleston IL. Lowe stated Eddy drove from Charleston IL to Bloomington IL to pick them up. Lowe believed Eddy picked them up between 2000 and 2100 hours. Eddy picked her and Wischart up at her mom's house. Once at Bloomington, Wischart got into the driver's seat, Lowe got into the front passenger seat, Eddy got into the back seat with her son. Lowe stated she had approximately 7-10 grams of Ice Methamphetamine in a bag in her bra. Lowe stated eddy had a vial of Methamphetamine on her person.

Lowe stated they left Bloomington and went to Champaign. Lowe stated they drove to Champaign and met a male named Wes, Willie Howard on Facebook. Once at Wes house, they obtained \$350 to go towards the \$1075. Wes was to get a cut of the Ice Methamphetamine.

Lowe stated Wells wanted them to meet him at a rest stop in Coalfield IL. Lowe stated they made up a story that their car died at Circle K in Springfield and got Wells to meet them there.

Lowe state they left Champaign and came into Springfield on I-72. As they came into Springfield, they pulled right into the Circle K gas station. Lowe stated Wells came into Springfield and went to the shell station across the street. Lowe stated she got into the driver seat and pulled out of Circle K as Wells pulled into Circle K in the orange SUV. They ended up driving to the Best Rest and pulled into the back of the lot.

Lowe stated she pulled in but was not able to get into a parking space. Wischart exited the front passenger seat and got into the orange SUV with Wells. A vehicle left from the Best Rest and Lowe backed up and pulled into the parking space. Wells got nervous because of the vehicle movement and left going back to the shell gas station. Lowe left and went to the shell station.

Lowe and Wischart got into an argument about Wells trying to rip them. Lowe stated Wells gave Wischart a black magnetic box containing the methamphetamine. Lowe stated Wells put the magnetic box on the muffler and melted the box to some of the Methamphetamine. Lowe never saw the Ice methamphetamine with Wischart returns. Lowe asked Wischart if he got all of it. Wischart told her that he got most of it.

When they got ready to leave, Eddy was driving, Wischart was in the front passenger seat, Lowe and the child were in the back seat. Lowe stated they were heading back to Bloomington when they stopped in Lincoln because Wischart could not find his wallet and the child had defecated himself. Lowe stated they stopped at Thornton's gas station in Lincoln IL. Lowe stated Wischart went inside to go to the bathroom and Eddy went in with the [REDACTED] clean [REDACTED] up.

Lowe said they left the Thornton's following the GPS when a police officer got behind them. They said everybody started freaking out. Lowe stated Eddy gave her all her drugs, Wischart gave her all his drugs. Lowe stated Eddy gave her a vial of methamphetamine. Lowe placed it into her bra. Lowe stated Wischart gave her a big bag of methamphetamine. Lowe placed it into her bra as well. Lowe stated the lights came on and they were stopped.

Once the stop was conducted, once Eddy was asked to exit and walk back to the quad car, Lowe stated she placed the Ice methamphetamine from her bra down the front of her pants. Lowe stated she placed the 7-10-gram bag of meth into her vagina. Lowe stated she tried to put the large bag of meth into her vagina, but it was too big.

Lowe stated she was requested to exit the vehicle and was placed into the rear of the squad car. Lowe stated she was worried a female officer would be requested to search her. Lowe took the vial and placed the vial between the seats. Lowe stated she worked over and over and finally got the big bag into her vagina. Lowe stated she was let out and was going to be released when the officer saw meth on the back seat, and she was arrested. Lowe stated the methamphetamine was still in her vagina. Lowe stated the Officers found the vial between the seats. Lowe stated she told the Officers at the jail that she had the methamphetamine in her vagina.

Lowe stated on the way to the ER, she was able to get the big bag out of her vagina and place it into her shirt. Once into the ER room, Lowe stated she got the bag out of her shirt and placed the bag under her. Lowe stated she was laying on the big bag of methamphetamine. Lowe was trying to find the right time to throw the bag into the garbage. Lowe stated when nobody was in the room, she moved the bag from underneath her and placed it inside the pillow. Lowe stated the reason the meth was getting everywhere was because it was loose, and it got inside her shirt and was stuck to her clothes and her back.

I asked Lowe if she was an addict to methamphetamine. Lowe said no, but yes when Wisehart is around.

I began to ask Lowe about other narcotic information, see interview for more information.

At approximately 1016 hours, the interview was concluded.

#### **EVIDENCE OF CELLULAR PHONES**

On October 5th, 2022, I received a black and green iridescent color, with black case, Motorola Cellular phone belonging to George E. Wisehart ( [REDACTED] ) from Deputy Grayson. I placed this phone into CID CIEG #5.

On October 5th, 2022, I received a black, with black case, Samsung, IMEI: [REDACTED] belonging to Chelsey L. Lowe [REDACTED] from CPL Hopp. I placed this phone into CID CIEG #5.

#### **EVIDENCE OF SECURITY FOOTAGE OF CIRCLE K GAS STATION**

On October 6th, 2022, I received the video footage from Circle K gas station located at 3261 Clearlake Avenue in Springfield IL. from store manager Lisa Griffiths. I reviewed the video which showed a blue car driven by Wisehart, Lowe in the front passenger seat, Eddy in the back seat with a young child arriving at approximately 2254 hours on October 2nd, 2022, into the Circle K gas station. The vehicle stops at a gas pump and stays parked there until 2355 hours. Wisehart, Eddy and the young child go into the gas station during the time between 2254 hours and 1155 hours and can be identified by the video. At 2355 hours, the vehicle leaves with Lowe driving, Wisehart in the front passenger seat, Eddy, and the young child in the back seat. An orange SUV appears to come into the lot and follow Lowe and Wisehart out of the lot onto Clearlake Avenue. The original copy was placed into CID CIEG #4. The original copy was obtained from Lisa Griffiths, Manager, at Circle K Gas station located at 3261 Clearlake Avenue in Springfield IL.

#### **EVIDENCE OF SECURITY FOOTAGE THORNTON'S GAS STATION**
