Case Summary:

On Sunday, 03/28/21, Lompoc Police Department officers responded to a "man with a gun" call. Upon their arrival, they were confronted by a subject (*Yvette K. Ruiz, DOB: [REDACTED]*) who jumped out of the bushes, and started running towards them, possibly armed with a knife. This incident resulted in an officer-involved-shooting.

The AR-15, assigned to the patrol unit, is being submitted for functionality testing. The weapon was rendered safe at the scene.

On Tuesday, 03/30/21, at 0845 hours, I spoke with Criminalist Supervisor Dave Barber (Goleta DOJ Crime Lab) and obtained verbal consent to submit the AR-15 and its ammunition (*Item#16, Tag#09070108*) for functionality testing.
