Summary Narrative

This report contains information of the video-documentation completed by Forensics on Sunday, 03/28/21, of the LOPD officer involved shooting scene as documented in SBSO Case#:21-3520.

NARRATIVE:

At 2045 hrs, I received a phone call from Sgt. McDonald advising that an officer involved shooting involving the Lompoc PD had occurred near the intersection of Walnut Avenue and North H Street in the city of Lompoc. Assistance from the Forensics Unit was being requested to process both the scene and the officers involved in the incident. I contacted Crime Scene Technicians Amezola and Avalos and requested they respond to the Hilton Garden Inn for officer processing in this case (Refer to Crime Scene Technician Amezola's report for further details).

At 2158 hrs, I arrived on scene and observed that it had been cordoned off with yellow crime scene tape. Members of the following agencies were present and waiting outside the cordoned off area: Lompoc PD personnel, Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office detectives, and Santa Barbara County District Attorney's Office personnel. At 2215 hrs, I called Tech. Sandoval and requested her assistance with photo-documentation of the scene and with evidence collection (*Refer to Tech. Sandoval's Supp. Report #0004 for details*). At 2233 hrs, SBSO Detective Esparza gave me an initial walk-through of the scene. Once completed I began the video-documentation process. Technician Sandoval arrived on scene at 2340 hrs. Technicians Amezola and Avalos later arrived on scene as Technician Sandoval was photo-documenting the scene.

VIDEO-DOCUMENTATION OF SCENE

At 2253 hrs, I used a Sony digital video camera to video-document the scene which included the following:

- Intersection of Walnut Avenue and North H Street & LOPD Patrol Unit #0216 (Lic#:1453067) closest to this
 intersection
- Intersection of Walnut Ave and North G Street & LOPD Chevy Impala CT vehicle (Lic#6YUK527) located at this intersection
- LOPD Patrol Unit 20022 (Lic#1591212) parked out in the street near the "Fascination & Technology" and "Victory Street 2 A Sequel" building (112 E. Walnut Ave)

Narrative

- Location of the decedent's body on the ground in the alley adjacent to "Victory Street 2 A Sequel" building
- Evidence previously marked by LOPD with yellow evidence placards 1-9
- LOPD Patrol Unit 0214 (Lic#1453070) in the alley facing E. Walnut Ave.

It should be noted that I inadvertently pressed the stop button on the first video. I immediately re-started the video for continuity purposes. Video-documentation was completed at 2318 hrs.

COLLECTION OF ITEM 15 (Tag 09070108)

One cell phone in a black Otter case (Item 15, Tag09070108) was found in the decedent's right front pant pocket. I took the phone out of the decedent's pant pocket and Technician Sandoval photographed it. At 0029 hrs on Monday, 03/29/21, I released this item to Det. Alegria for investigative purposes.

The Forensics Unit left the scene at 0230 hrs on Monday, 03/29/21. The scene remained cordoned off and was kept secured overnight by law enforcement. A daylight search of the scene could be completed by members of the Forensics Unit and members of the Search & Rescue Units later that day (*Refer to Technician Sandoval's Supp. Report #0005 for details*).
