Instructions for submitting evidence

USE THIS BFS 1 FOR

The BFS 1 submittal form is to be used for the following types of cases:

- Criminalistics (Including DNA)
 - Latent Fingerprints
 - Questioned Documents
 - Clandestine Laboratory Analysis

INFORMATION AND REPORT SECURITY

The submitting agency determines the case security:

Routine: Case information may be released to members of the submitting and related agencies and the District Attorney's office.

Agency Only: Case information is restricted to members of the submitting agency.

Agent Only: Case information is to be released only to the named agent (investigating officer) of the submitting agency.

No BFS employee may release any information regarding an investigation or the results of any analysis unless it is within the security restricts applied to the case.

PACKAGING

General evidence packaging guidelines:

- All evidence must be packaged to prevent contamination and loss.
- Evidence containers *must* be tape or heat sealed and initialed/marked on the seal.
- Place your agency name, case number, and item number on each package.

Please call the lab if you have a question about how to package a specific piece or type of evidence.

CHAIN OF CUSTODY

Each item of evidence must have a clear chain of custody:

- All items on a BFS 1 should have their chain of custody listed on the same page.
 - Each item of evidence must be listed. If the statement "All of the above" is used in the Chain of Custody section then strike out any unused lines in the Evidence Submitted section.
 - Avoid phrases such as "items 1-10" unless all of the items are included. For example, if item 9 is not included write "items 1-8, and 10".

DO NOT USE THE BFS 1 FORM FOR :

Do not use the BFS 1 form for routine:

- Drugs (use the BFS 2 envelope)
- Toxicology (Use the BFS 8 or Tox 11550 envelope)
- Blood alcohol (use the BFS 8 envelope)

It is only necessary to fill out the face of the above evidence envelopes for submittal to the lab.
