On 4-21-21, I received two Physical Evidence Examination Reports from the DOJ (Department of Justice). The first report documented the test firing of the AR-15 that Officer Calderon fired during the OIS. In summary, the rifle functioned appropriately. The second report documented the test firing of Cpl. White and Officer Calderon's firearms. In summary, both guns functioned appropriately.

On 4-30-21, I received one Physical Evidence Examination Report from the DOJ (Department of Justice). The report documented the examination of the expended round that had been located by Detective Vasquez during the line search (supplemental report # 005). In summary, the class characteristics of the bullet were similar to the bullet characteristics observed in the submitted ammunition of Cpl. White's Glock 17, Generation 4 firearm.
