#### **Narrative**

#### SEARCH FOR UNACCOUNTED ROUNDS & COLLECTION OF EVIDENCE ITEM 1 (Tag 09070109):

At 0950 hours on Monday, 03/29/21, CSI Technician Amezola and I arrived on scene. The crime scene was still cordoned off with yellow crime scene tape from the previous night. The scene had been secured overnight by law enforcement personnel for daylight processing.

Upon arrival we contacted Forensic Supervisor Fabela, Detective Joel Rivlin, Detective Jason Vasquez, and Search and Rescue personnel. The purpose of this was to conduct a line search for unaccounted rounds. I was tasked first with taking overall photographs of the scene.

At approximately 1000 hours on Monday, 03/29/21, I took overall and close up digital photographs of the scene beginning at the intersection of Walnut St & North H St, made my way to Walnut St & North G St, walked through the alley way to the right of the Fascination & Technology building, and then walked around the open area where the line search was being conducted.

When my overall photographs were completed, I joined the line search. CSI Technician Amezola conducted a metal detector search of the open area as well but the search yielded negative results. At 1100 hours, Detective Vasquez located an expended round (*item 1*).

CSI Technician Amezola and I collected several pieces of brain matter and pieces of bone. Refer to photographs for details. These were placed in a bag and will be taken to the Coroner's Office for disposal.

Possible impact marks were located at the scene. These areas were photographed.

The line search was completed at 1153 hours. Forensic Supervisor Fabela, CSI Technician Amezola, and I left the scene at 1200 hours. We arrived at the Santa Maria station at 1238 hours. Item 1 was placed in the Forensics
