Re: 2022 Chronic Nuisance Premises Ordinance Summary

Pursuant to M.G.O 25.09 (12), the Police Department reports:

A. Number of properties in 2022 that have been declared Chronic Nuisance Premises:

Three. The declaration occurs when a letter is sent by the Madison Police Department in accordance with the criteria set forth in the Chronic Nuisance Premises ordinance, informing the premise owner that their property has been declared a Chronic Nuisance Premises.

- 1. 6302 Milwaukee St, single family house, declared in June 2022
- 2. 5317 High Crossing Blvd, hotel, declared in June 2020
- 3. 7399 Tree Lane, multi-unit apartment building, declared May 2019
- B. Length of time for abatement to occur:
 - 1. 6302 Milwaukee Street- 4 months
 - 2. 5317 High Crossing Blvd- 14 months
 - 3. 7399 Tree Lane- unabated
- C. Number of times the cost recovery provision was used and the dollar amount collected under this provision: One.
 - 1. 7399 Tree Lane, \$529.68 billed in April 2022, but unpaid
