Ms. Katerina,

On May 31st 2024, you filed a complaint with Miami-Dade Animal Services with regard to a, **large brown/white female Labrador Retriever mix named “Cupcake”** belonging to Jordan Leonard. We were requested to investigate whether or not this dog should be declared dangerous under Section 5-22 of the Miami-Dade County Code. The purpose of this letter is to issue the findings of our investigation and whether or not a preliminary determination of dangerous dog should be entered in this case.

In making a preliminary determination as to whether or not a dog should be declared dangerous, a preponderance of the evidence submitted to Animal Services must support the fact that a violation of Section 5-22 has occurred. **After reviewing the case file the department has determined that there is insufficient cause to declare this dog as dangerous at this time.**
