Mr. Leonard,

On May 31<sup>st</sup> 2024, a complaint was filed with Miami-Dade Animal Services against your dog **large brown/white female Labrador Retriever mix named n “Cupcake”**. We were requested to investigate whether or not your dogs should be declared dangerous under section 5-22 of the Miami-Dade County code. The purpose of this letter is to issue the findings of our investigation and whether or not a preliminary determination of dangerous dog should be entered in this case.

In making a preliminary determination as to whether or not a dog should be declared dangerous, the preponderance of the evidence must support that a violation of section 5-22 of the Miami-Dade County Code has occurred. **At this time the Animal Services Department believes that there is insufficient cause to declare your dog as dangerous under section 5-22.** Because of these findings the investigation is closed at this time.
