**RE: CALIFORNIA PUBLIC RECORDS ACT REQUEST DATED DECEMBER 11, 2024;
NOTICE OF DETERMINATION**

To Bradford Davis and Yelena Dzhanova,

The City of Newport Beach ("City") received your California Public Records Act ("Act") (Govt. Code §§7920.000 *et seq.*) request dated December 11, 2024. Pursuant to Government Code Section 7922.535(a), the City is typically required to respond to requests made under the Act within ten (10) days. However, if "unusual circumstances" exist, the ten (10) day time limit prescribed in Section 7922.535(a) may be extended up to fourteen (14) days (Gov. Code §7922.535(b)).

In this case, unusual circumstances exist that require the City to take additional time to determine whether the request, in whole or in part, seeks copies of disclosable public records in the possession of the City. Specifically, additional time to search for, collect, and appropriately examine a voluminous amount of separate and distinct records that are demanded in your request (Gov. Code §7922.535 (c)(2)).

Based thereon, the City will respond to your request with a notice of determination as to whether the request, in whole or in part, seeks the production of non-exempt, non-privileged disclosable public records in the possession of the City, pursuant to the Act on or before January 04, 2025.
