



ADDENDUM TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

In the effort to provide a safe environment for learning in the Nauset School District, as governed by Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 12 Section 32 the Cape and Islands District Attorney's Office agrees to hold Community Based Justice Meetings. These meetings will coordinate efforts of the criminal justice system in addressing juvenile justice through cooperation with the schools and local law enforcement representatives, Probation and court representatives and, where appropriate, the Department of Children and Families, Department of Youth Services and Department of Mental Health. The Community Based Justice Meeting will be the primary point of information sharing. At these meetings, The Cape & Islands District Attorney's Office will be responsible for creating, managing and updating a priority prosecution list of individuals identified as the community's most serious violent youths and repeat offenders and shall update the list as events may happen and the individual is moved through the criminal justice system. The Cape & Islands District Attorney's Office shall treat the identified cases as priority prosecution cases and impose individualized sanctions designed to deter the offender from further criminal or delinquent conduct. These meetings will offer the Nauset School and Orleans Police Department the opportunity to provide input to be considered in the prosecution of the case.


