Instructions

- Think about how you might respond from multiple perspectives e.g., teacher, support staff, counselor, etc.
- Try changing the race or ethnicity of the youth and see if you would respond differently. Consider how your response might differ based on the young person's age.

Scenarios

- 1. You ask a Muslim youth how his day is going, and he says, "Someone said I was going to be banned from school."
- 2. A white teen says, "I can't get any scholarships because I'm white."
- 3. A Mexican-American teenager says, "I hate Mexican music."
- 4. An African-American teenaged male repeatedly comments on how pretty the White girls are and says, "They don't have attitude."
- 5. An African-American youth is preparing to take a difficult English exam and is exhibiting some anxiety. He tells you he's worried because, "Last year my Language Arts teacher told me I need to be more articulate in my writing."
- 6. A Somali student says, "When I get a job the first thing I'm going to do is buy blue contact lenses with my money."
- 7. A White male student comes to school wearing a hat with the Confederate Battle Flag.
- 8. You overhear two White girls in upset voices stating, "The Indians are getting the good grades making it hard for us to get good grades!"
- 9. A Trans student shares with you that he's changed his pronouns over the summer from she/her/hers to he/him/his. During class another student unintentionally misidentifies him in front of the entire class.
- 10. An Asian student says "I'm supposed to be good at math but I'm getting a B."
- 11. A White student says to another White student, "I don't like Mormons."
- 12. A student calls another student, "Retard," loud enough for the entire class to hear.
- 13. A Chinese student awkwardly blames everything he is good at or has challenges with on being Chinese.
- 14. A group of boys refers to people speaking in Spanish as, "UnAmerican."
- 15. A group of male students tells a female student, "Why are you wasting your time learning [STEM subject]? You know you're just going to grow up to have babies, right?!"
