### Reason

I asked the driver of the vehicle if there was any marijuana inside of the vehicle and he stated " no" at this time I asked the driver to pull his vehicle over to the side of the road. When I re approached the vehicle I asked the driver again if he had any marijuana inside of the vehicle and he then again stated " no ". During this time of me asking him he would not make eye contact with me and was very nervous and shaking. I noticed the passenger in the front seat kept looking at me and then she would look back at the driver. She then stated " do you just want me to give it to him " I then asked her if there was any marijuana in the vehicle and she stated " yes it is in the center console ". I then asked the driver and two passenger to step out of the vehicle so I could conduct my search. In the center console I located one small clear in color box inside of the box I located a small clear in color baggie with a green leafy substance inside of it ( marijuana ), I also located 3 " GAME" cigar packs used for smoking marijuana and a black in color digital scale used for weighing marijuana. Once I located these items I asked who the items belonged to and the driver [REDACTED] stated " it is mine ". I continued my search of the vehicle and did not locate anything else. I issued [REDACTED] a state citation for simple possession of marijuana, and possession of drug paraphernalia.

This case was dismissed and the evidence in this case has been placed on a Order of Destruction.
