After seeking an extension of 2 weeks due to quantity, size of files and review of files; this response to your request is being provided to you on the 18th business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

The following records are being provided and are responsive to your request:

The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
