Your certification number will remain the same, regardless of the employing Agency. Your certification also includes the designation of an SRO in accordance with 555 CMR 10.00. This indicates that you have completed the required training to serve as a School Resource Officer. This additional designation of SRO will expire in conjunction with your Certification.

Your certification is valid for a period of three years from the date of issue, unless it is suspended, revoked or the Officer is otherwise determined decertified..

Note that you must remain in compliance with the requirements of Chapter 6E and all rules and regulations promulgated by the Commission for the duration of your employment as a law enforcement officer. Also, the Commission will not be able to recertify you upon the expiration of your new certification period if it finds that you do not continue to satisfy the requirements of M.G.L. c. 6E, § 4(f).
