22-0896**INFORMATION REPORT - WELFARE CHECK**

On May 12, 2022, at approximately 1048 hours, I received a radio call of a possible suicidal subject at [REDACTED] (Lluvia Building). Comments of the call indicated the subject had ordered food through Starship delivery service and had written, "*i am going to kell myself with a sawed off*" in the notes section while ordering. The subject was determined to be [REDACTED].

Kelly Kuehnert (UCI Dining, Food Service Director) was the reporting party on this incident and provided me a screenshot of the message (See Photos Section.)

Officer Phou #953, Corporal Rios #944, and I responded to [REDACTED] and made contact with the subject's roommates. [REDACTED] was not present in the room but we were advised by [REDACTED] roommates that [REDACTED] was possibly in a therapy session at the UCI Counseling Center.

Corporal Rios and I responded to the UCI Counseling Center and upon arrival, I received a telephone call from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated to me that he was sitting inside the Counseling Center and would be willing to meet in person to discuss the incident.

At approximately 1153 hours, I made contact with [REDACTED] and asked [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] had typed the message on the Starship order. [REDACTED] admitted to writing the message but stated [REDACTED] was not suicidal and had done it only as a joke for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] did not think anyone would read the message and that [REDACTED] was embarrassed by the situation.

I asked [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] had any other thoughts of harming [REDACTED] or others and [REDACTED] stated, "No." [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was seeking therapy at the UCI Counseling Center for other concerns.

[REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] had no history of making suicidal statements or attempts in the past and that he was not currently diagnosed with any mental illness. [REDACTED] did state [REDACTED] has shown possible signs of depression but that he was not officially diagnosed or taking any medication.

I asked [REDACTED] if he owned any weapons (referencing the "sawed-off" portion of his message) and [REDACTED] stated he was not in possession and did not own any weapons. I later conducted a records check through the Automated Firearms System which returned negative results.

After speaking with [REDACTED] several minutes, I determined [REDACTED] did not meet the criteria for a 5150 WIC evaluation hold. I advised [REDACTED] was free to leave and this concluded our contact.
