On March 29, 2024, the Village of Burr Ridge received your written request for public records pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”). In your FOIA request you sought the following records.

“A copy of the most recent property & casualty insurance renewal summary for all lines of insurance purchased by the public entity (general liability, auto, workers comp, professional, directors and officers, etc.) This document summarizes the insurance terms, limits, deductibles, premium and exclusions. The document(s) should also show what company/companies brokered, sold, and/or underwrote said policies.”

I. **Denial of Request**

Your request for records is hereby denied in its entirety. The reason(s) for denial are stated in Section III, below.

II. **The Person Responsible for the Denial:**

III. **The Reasons For The Denial:**

Your request for records is denied, in whole or in part, because the records are exempt from disclosure pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, for the following reason(s):

Records containing any and all proprietary information and records related to the operation of an intergovernmental risk management association or self-insurance pool or jointly self-administered health and accident cooperative or pool are exempt. Insurance or self-insurance (including any intergovernmental risk management association or self-insurance pool) claims, loss or risk management information, records, data, advice, or communications are also exempt. (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(s))

IV. **Notice of the Right to Review by The Public Access Counselor and Notice of Right to Judicial Review**

You have the right to file a request for review by the Public Access Counselor of the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. The Public Access Counselor may be contacted at


