

Synopsis:

Professor ARTHUR H. ROSENFELD reinterviewed at University of California. Recalls that in about 1952 Applicant left car in his care and that car was observed parked in vicinity of Progressive Party meeting. ROSENFELD advised Applicant not involved in subversive activities and recommends for position of trust.

DETAILS:

AT BERKELEY, CALIFORNIA

On January 11, 1963 Professor ~~ARTHUR H. ROSENFELD~~ <sup>Arthur Rosenfeld Calif. Ill.</sup>, Professor of Physics, University of California, advised he recalled that both ROSENFELD and the Applicant were at the University of Chicago in about 1952 and 1953. He stated that ROSENFELD was a graduate student while the Applicant was an instructor. He stated that in about 1952 the Applicant had traveled to Europe and left his automobile in care of ROSENFELD. ROSENFELD advised he believed he had loaned this car to a person named NINA BYERS and that she had possibly attended a meeting of the Progressive Party near which the car was reportedly parked. He stated that the Applicant was not connected in any subversive activity and that he would recommend him for a position of trust.
