NARRATIVE											

On Wednesday, 07/19/2017, at approximately 2117 hours I, Security Officer FORREST BROWN with the Santa Cruz Seaside Company (SCSC), was on uniformed patrol along the Santa Cruz Beach Boardwalk and its properties. At that time, I was approached by an SCSC Ticket Sales and Parking employee ANGELO SALINAS, who brought me a suspicious disc.

I then took the suspicious disk to guest services to be placed in lost and found. At a later time, SCSC Sergeant DAVID KATICH, requested a meet at station 2. Upon my arrival, he notified me that an identical disk to the one that was given to me was brought to him. I then went to lost and found and brought the disk over to compare the two disks. Upon further investigation KATICH determined that the disks were identical, and I attached digital photographs of the discs to the face page of this report. KATICH then viewed the disc and determined there was suspicious material on the discs and requested the Santa Cruz Police Department to assist us.

I then requested for SALINAS to come meet me at Guest Services so I could interview him. SALINAS then meet me at Guest Services and I asked him where he found the disc. SALINAS then proceeded to tell me that he found the first disc inside the Men's Carousel restroom in the second stall at approximately 1920 hours. SALINAS then said that he found the second disc inside the Men's Neptune's restroom on the counter next to the sink at approximately 2020 hours. SALINAS also said

that he didn't see any possible suspects and that all that he knew. I then told SALINAS that he was free Togo back to work.

SCSC Lieutenant DANIEL HEDDEN came on scene and investigated the disc further. HEDDEN determined that the disk was suspicious, and that he is going to forward the disc to the Northern California Regional Intelligence Center for further investigation.

SCPD Officer MATT MULVIHILL then came on scene at station 2. Once on scene MULVIHILL viewed the disc and determined the disc was suspicious and took the disc for further investigation. For further reference, you can refer to SCPD case number 17s-05837.

All units were cleared without further incident at approximately 2157 hours.
