SYNOPSIS
 ACCORDING TO THE REPORTED INFORMATION, THE DECEDENT IS A 19 YEAR-OLD HISPANIC FEMALE WITH A MEDICAL HISTORY OF DEPRESSION AND AT LEAST 2 PRIOR SUICIDE ATTEMPTS. ON WEDNESDAY 09/04/2019 AT 2141 HOURS, THE ENGINEER SAW THE DECEDENT SITTING ON HER KNEES ON THE TRACK AND THEN LAY DOWN ACROSS THE TRACK. THE ENGINEER SET THE EMERGENCY BRAKES, BUT THE TRAIN WAS UNABLE TO STOP IN TIME. THE FREIGHT TRAIN THEN RAN OVER THE DECEDENT. 911 WAS CALLED AND OFFICERS FROM THE POMONA POLICE DEPARTMENT, OFFICERS FROM THE UNION PACIFIC POLICE DEPARTMENT AND PARAMEDICS FROM THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT ARRIVED ON-SCENE. ON WEDNESDAY 09/04/2019 AT 2145 HOURS, CAPTAIN JOHNSON FROM ENG187 DETERMINED DEATH. A SUICIDE NOTE WAS LOCATED AT THE DECEDENT'S RESIDENCE AND THERE ARE NO SIGNS OF FOUL PLAY.

Investigation:

On Wednesday 09/04/2019 at 2240 hours, Officer Solgat from the Pomona Police Department called the Los Angeles County Medical Examiner-Coroner's Office to report a suicidal death of a Hispanic male, unknown age, that was struck by a train. On Wednesday 09/04/2019 at 2250 hours Lieutenant Larry Dietz assigned this case to me. I arrived on-scene at 2325 hours and I cleared the scene on Thursday 09/05/2019 at 0250 hours. Forensic Attendant Lorenzo Cervantes transported the decedent from the scene to the Decedent Services Unit. A suicide note was located at the decedent's residence and was brought to the scene. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] It is signed by the decedent using the name Andrew Elijah Martinez, but it is not dated. A photocopy of the suicide note is included with my report. There are no signs of foul play.

Location:

The incident occurred and the decedent died on the north set of train tracks south of the business located at 2870 Pomona Boulevard, Pomona CA, 91767.

Informant/Witness Statements:

I spoke with Officer Acosta at the scene, and he told me the following:

On Wednesday 09/04/2019 at approximately 2140 hours, a freight train, approximately 8,000' in length with 2 engines in the front was travelling westbound at approximately 38 mph on the north set of train tracks. At 2141 hours, the engineer saw the decedent lay down on the north set of tracks. The engineer sounded the horn and set the emergency brakes and at 2142 hours, the train ran over the decedent. 911 was called and Paramedics from the Los Angeles County Fire Department arrived on-scene. On Wednesday 09/04/2019 at 2145 hours, Captain Johnson from ENG187 determined death. Per the video, the decedent was seen sitting on his knees, and then lays down onto his back, with his head facing south and his legs out in front of him. The road leading to the crossing where the incident occurred is blocked off by a locked gate and there is no public access to this road. There are no signs of foul play.

I also spoke with Officer Rodriguez at the scene, and he told me the following:

On Wednesday 09/04/2019, the decedent was talking on-line with his boyfriend, and he told him that he was going to kill himself. The decedent wrote a suicide note that he left at his residence, leaving all of his property to friends. It is unknown what the decedent was depressed about.

I later spoke with [REDACTED] over the phone, and she told me the following:

The decedent started suffering from depression in 2016, when the decedent was taken away from her. She went to court multiple times to get the decedent back, but she always lost. The decedent was in foster care/group homes for over a year. Approximately 1 year ago, she was

told that the decedent attempted suicide and she went to a hospital, but that was all she was told. She did not know how the decedent attempted suicide and what hospital she was transported to. Then, approximately 2 months ago, the decedent attempted suicide by overdosing on an unknown substance, and she was transported to Pomona Valley Hospital. She could not provide any further information regarding the decedent.

Scene Description:

The incident occurred on the north set of railroad tracks located south of the business located at 2870 Pomona Boulevard in Pomona. There were 3 sets of railroad tracks that had slight curve feet east of where the incident occurred. The tracks then become straight and flat where the incident occurred. It was dark and clear at the time of the incident. North of the railroad tracks, east of the 57 Freeway was business. North of the railroad tracks, west of the 57 Freeway was a dirt lot. South of the railroad tracks, east of the 57 Freeway was a cemetery and grassy area. South of the railroad tracks, west of the 57 Freeway was a business. There was a railroad crossing just east of the 57 Freeway that led to a dirt path to the cemetery. It had flashing lights, downed arms, and ringing bells, all of which were working properly at the time of the incident.

The freight train was located resting on the north set of railroad tracks. The 1st engine was facing west and I was unable to see the rear of the train. There was blood and brain matter on the engine on the gas tank of the 1st engine.

There was a blood smear and some brain matter on the north side of the crossing, just south of the north tracks. Located feet west along the north set of tracks and just south of the north set of tracks were multiple pieces of brain matter, human debris, pieces of skull, pieces of ribs, and blood splatter. Amongst the debris, was the decedent's right hand and part of her right arm, which was located just south of the north set of tracks. Her forearm was located inside a sweatshirt and there was a black beanie with the sweatshirt. Located just south of her forearm was a piece of a fractured rib. Located a few feet northwest of her right arm, was the decedent's left arm, torso, and legs. Located just east of her torso was a kidney, and located a few feet southwest of her torso, just south of the north set of train tracks were multiple pieces of brain matter, an unknown piece of one of her organs, a piece of skull, and other human debris. Located feet west of the decedent's torso was her other kidney. There were multiple pieces of brain matter extending feet west just south of the north set of train tracks. Located feet south of the north set of train tracks was a large piece of skull. Located a few feet northwest of that large piece of skull, in the middle of the north set of train tracks was part of the decedent's rib cage, her right shoulder, and part of her right arm. Located a few feet west of her rib cage, was the decedent's left sneaker and part of a fractured rib. Located just south of the north set of train tracks was another piece of a fractured rib. Located southwest of that piece of fractured rib, south of the north set of train tracks, were multiple blood marks leading up to the decedent's head. The decedent's right sneaker was located on the north set of train tracks, feet west of the 57 Freeway.

Evidence:

I did not collect any evidence regarding this case.

Body Examination:

The decedent is a 19 year-old Hispanic female with short black hair and brown eyes. It appears that the decedent has all of her upper and all of her lower natural teeth. There are multiple old healed scars covering the majority of her inner right forearm. There are multiple new recent cuts covering her inner central right forearm. There are multiple old healed scars covering the majority of her inner left forearm. The decedent was wearing a black long sleeve sweatshirt, a black short sleeve T-shirt, a pair of black pants with a black belt, a pair of black boxer briefs, and a pair of green camouflage socks. The decedent's head was traumatically amputated at the

neck and was located south of the north set of train tracks and north of the middle set of train tracks. The top of her head was facing south. Her right arm was traumatically amputated just below the elbow and was located lying just south of the north set of train tracks. The decedent was lying prone across the north set of railroad tracks. The decedent's left arm was almost traumatically amputated, and was attached to the torso by a piece of skin. The left arm was bent at the elbow and her left hand was resting on her right foot, just north of the south rail. Her right leg was bent at multiple places, and her right foot was just south of the south rail and was pointing west. Her left leg was straight with her left foot pointing north. There was a major laceration across the upper portion of her torso with multiple organs exposed. The decedent sustained multiple rib and spinal fractures. There were abrasions covering the majority of the top of her right forearm and her right and left arms were fractured. There were abrasions to her outer right hip and her right thigh was fractured. There were abrasions and a laceration to the front of her left leg. The decedent sustained a major laceration to her forehead, major lacerations to both of her eyebrows, and a major laceration to the right and left sides of her head. There were multiple abrasions covering the majority of the decedent's face and the decedent sustained multiple skull and facial fractures. Rigor mortis was absent and lividity was not observed.

Identification:

The decedent cannot be positively identified visually and she does not have fingerprints on file. The decedent is probably Yaeli Mozelle Galdamez and Andrew Elijah Martinez both with a DOB of 04/23/2000. Please see case notes for further information.

Next of Kin Notification:

On Thursday 09/05/2019 at 0815 hours, I tentatively notified [REDACTED] the decedent's mother, of her [REDACTED] death via telephone. She stated that the decedent does not have a will, she is not married, and she does not have any children.


Tissue Donation:
