

# ***Pat Swindall, Congressman Undone by Scandal, Is Dead at 67***

Pat Swindall, a former congressman from Georgia whose political career was derailed by a perjury conviction, died on Wednesday. He was 67.

His former campaign manager and chief of staff, Robb Austin, confirmed the death but did not say where Mr. Swindall died or what the cause was.

A Republican from Atlanta's eastern suburbs, Mr. Swindall served two terms in Congress, from 1985 to 1989, at a time when Georgia's political landscape was dominated by Democrats.

He was elected in 1984, beating the five-term Democratic incumbent, Elliott Levitas. At the time, Newt Gingrich was the only other Georgia Republican serving in the House of Representatives.
