Re: Investigative Report Request for Information Related to Longwood Gardens /and/ Danelo Cavalcante

Dear Agency Records Officer,

AtNight Media, a subsidiary of One World Media Corp., under the broader umbrella of WorldNexus Corporation (collectively the “News Corporations”), hereby submits a request for access to and copies of records concerning interactions between Longwood Gardens and your agency, specifically between August 31, 2023, and October 1, 2023.

I. Request

A. SMS, MMS, AND MESSAGING APP COMMUNICATIONS

Records of all forms of text-based messages (SMS, MMS, and messaging apps) exchanged between the individuals involved in the manhunt for Danilo “Danelo” Souza Cavalcante “(or “Cavalcante”) within your agency and representatives and Longwood Gardens personnel, including but not limited to the following Longwood Gardens representatives, from August 31, 2023, to October 1, 2023:

B. E-MAIL COMMUNICATIONS

1. Any email communications sent or received between your agency's email addresses and “@longwoodgardens.org” between August 31, 2023, and the October 1, 2023.

For absolute clarity, this request aims to obtain communications between the specific agency, personnel, contractors, or representatives involved in the operations, information dissemination, or collection regarding Danelo Cavalcante and Longwood Gardens, including its agents, representatives, and employees.¹

It is important to emphasize that the pursuit is not for internal communications within your Agency, except where such communications explicitly involve a Longwood Gardens

¹ It's important to note that this request is specifically for exchanges between the Agency and Longwood Gardens, not for internal communications within the Agency itself unless said communications include a Longwood representative, regardless of their position at the attraction.

representative. The presence of a Longwood Gardens associate in these communications, irrespective of their position or status within the organization, is the pivotal criterion of our request.

This material is not in relation to any ongoing criminal investigation pertaining to Danilo “Danelo” Souza Cavalcante as the News Corporations are exploring potential misconduct and financial interests rather than any investigative material.

It is believed that Longwood Gardens played a significant role in shaping the narrative of this case, allegedly participating in drafting press statements, and controlling information flow. There are concerns about the disappearance of a September 8th release, which some suggest was an attempt to minimize perceived accountability.

There are worries about Longwood's alleged use of influence and professional networks to sway police actions during the period of turmoil. In rare instances where crucial visual evidence is not found, it raises concerns about what might be intentionally concealed.

When a well-funded entity seems to manipulate processes and personnel covertly, it poses a substantial threat to open governance, undermining trust, and integrity at an institutional level.

The News Corporations’ request serves the public interest by potentially shedding light on significant public safety and law enforcement operations. Thus, we request a waiver of all associated fees, arguing that the disclosure significantly benefits general understanding. Should a fee waiver not be granted, kindly estimate the charges before processing.²

We affirm that this request is not for commercial purposes but is intended to inform and engage the public on matters of significant interest involving public safety and law enforcement collaborations, especially when a special interest worth more than one billion dollars was



We request that the information be provided electronically, ideally via email attachment to facilitate efficient dissemination and review.
