The placement of myself in solitary prior to medical screening for an elderly fully disabled adult with chronic medical issues is a felony, F.S. § 825.102, by the LCSO.

See statute excerpts (full statute below) concerning the immediate placement of myself into solitary in a 55 degree cell barefoot with only a thin t-shirt and shorts without any bedding that drove my body temperature down to 97.0, i.e. torture/malicious punishment.

(b) Willfully tortures, maliciously punishes, or willfully and unlawfully cages, an elderly person or disabled adult; or

1. A caregiver's failure or omission to provide an elderly person or disabled adult with the care, supervision, and services necessary to maintain the elderly person's or disabled adult's physical and mental health, including, but not limited to, food, nutrition, clothing, shelter, supervision, medicine, and medical services that a prudent person would consider essential for the well-being of the elderly person or disabled adult; or

These felonies are *per se* medical malpractice and caregiver malpractice as they are felonies against the elderly disabled. Thank you. --Scott huminski

Hi, I am in receipt of your recent letters.

I believe that the sheriff's medical staff lied about my medical record to gain State/Federal funding or grants, etc. concerning their lies input into my medical records.

I am not on Social Security Disability because of "street drug" use as lied to by the LCSO. I grant the FlHealth.gov power of attorney to access my first 5 years of medicare/social security records. I am on Social Security for joint issues, avascular necrosis, PTSD, Social Phobia, GAD. Now spinal stenosis and spinal disk degradation are added to the list.

I don't use "street drugs" as mentioned several times in the LCSO medical records. Medical marijuana and prescriptions filled at Walmart are not "street drugs". All of this is a lie, probably to secure funding or for some other improper motive.

False "street drug" information entered by the LCSO medical staff caused me to be place on "DETOX" for 10 days which prevented me from obtaining sleep medication for 10 days. Lies in medical records can cause injury. I once had a bogus allergy to penicillin sneak unto my records elsewhere and that led to my treatment with a lesser effective drug. False medical information is dangerous to the safety of the patient. During those first 10 days, I got 2-3 hours of sleep a night as a result of LCSO lies. Also felony abuse of a elderly disabled adult. See statute below.

Florida Statutes Title XLVI. Crimes § 825.102. Abuse, aggravated abuse, and neglect of an elderly person or disabled adult

(1) "Abuse of an elderly person or disabled adult" means:

(a) Intentional infliction of physical or psychological injury upon an elderly person or disabled adult;

(b) An intentional act that could reasonably be expected to result in physical or psychological injury to an elderly person or disabled adult; or

(c) Active encouragement of any person to commit an act that results or could reasonably be expected to result in physical or psychological injury to an elderly person or disabled adult.

A person who knowingly or willfully abuses an elderly person or disabled adult without causing great bodily harm, permanent disability, or permanent disfigurement to the elderly person or disabled adult commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in [s. 775.082](#) , [s. 775.083](#) , or [s. 775.084](#) .

(2) "Aggravated abuse of an elderly person or disabled adult" occurs when a person:

(a) Commits aggravated battery on an elderly person or disabled adult;

(b) Willfully tortures, maliciously punishes, or willfully and unlawfully cages, an elderly person or disabled adult; or

(c) Knowingly or willfully abuses an elderly person or disabled adult and in so doing causes great bodily harm, permanent disability, or permanent disfigurement to the elderly person or disabled adult.

A person who commits aggravated abuse of an elderly person or disabled adult commits a felony of the first degree, punishable as provided in [s. 775.082](#) , [s. 775.083](#) , or [s. 775.084](#) .

(3)(a) "Neglect of an elderly person or disabled adult" means:

1. A caregiver's failure or omission to provide an elderly person or disabled adult with the care, supervision, and services necessary to maintain the elderly person's or disabled adult's physical and mental health, including, but not limited to, food, nutrition, clothing, shelter, supervision, medicine, and medical services that a prudent person would consider essential for the well-being of the elderly person or disabled adult; or

2. A caregiver's failure to make a reasonable effort to protect an elderly person or disabled adult from abuse, neglect, or exploitation by another person.

Neglect of an elderly person or disabled adult may be based on repeated conduct or on a single incident or omission that results in, or could reasonably be expected to result in, serious physical or psychological injury, or a substantial risk of death, to an elderly person or disabled adult.

(b) A person who willfully or by culpable negligence neglects an elderly person or disabled adult and in so doing causes great bodily harm, permanent disability, or permanent disfigurement to the elderly person or disabled adult commits a felony of the second degree, punishable as provided in [s. 775.082](#) , [s. 775.083](#) , or [s. 775.084](#) .

(c) A person who willfully or by culpable negligence neglects an elderly person or disabled adult without causing great bodily harm, permanent disability, or permanent disfigurement to the elderly person or disabled adult commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in [s. 775.082](#) , [s. 775.083](#) , or [s. 775.084](#) .

Hi, I am writing to ascertain if more input from myself is required for the above board complaints.

Cutting my beta blockers 75% from 200 mg to 50 per day (with a less effective drug), when there was a recent hospitalization for transient ischemic attack (mini stroke) is not only unethical and a violation of medical norms (especially without initiating a physician / patient relationship) and blindly prescribing is abuse of a disabled adult. I have been on on SSDI for 10 years.

This is a felony in Florida and a federal civil rights crime (8th Amendment violation) punishable under federal civil rights crime statutes 18 USC 241, 242. Please refer this to the U.S. Attorney, the FDLE and the Florida and U.S. Attorney Generals. Thanks -- scott huminski

Florida Statutes Title XLVI. Crimes § 825.102. Abuse, aggravated abuse, and neglect of an elderly person or disabled adult

(1) "Abuse of an elderly person or disabled adult" means:

(a) Intentional infliction of physical or psychological injury upon an elderly person or disabled adult;

(b) An intentional act that could reasonably be expected to result in physical or psychological injury to an elderly person or disabled adult; or

(c) Active encouragement of any person to commit an act that results or could reasonably be expected to result in physical or psychological injury to an elderly person or disabled adult.

A person who knowingly or willfully abuses an elderly person or disabled adult without causing great bodily harm, permanent disability, or permanent disfigurement to the elderly person or disabled adult commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in [s. 775.082](#) , [s. 775.083](#) , or [s. 775.084](#) .

(2) "Aggravated abuse of an elderly person or disabled adult" occurs when a person:

(a) Commits aggravated battery on an elderly person or disabled adult;

(b) Willfully tortures, maliciously punishes, or willfully and unlawfully cages, an elderly person or disabled adult; or

(c) Knowingly or willfully abuses an elderly person or disabled adult and in so doing causes great bodily harm, permanent disability, or permanent disfigurement to the elderly person or disabled adult.

A person who commits aggravated abuse of an elderly person or disabled adult commits a felony of the first degree, punishable as provided in [s. 775.082](#) , [s. 775.083](#) , or [s. 775.084](#) .

(3)(a) "Neglect of an elderly person or disabled adult" means:

1. A caregiver's failure or omission to provide an elderly person or disabled adult with the care, supervision, and services necessary to maintain the elderly person's or disabled adult's physical and mental health, including, but not limited to, food, nutrition, clothing, shelter, supervision, medicine, and medical services that a prudent person would consider essential for the well-being of the elderly person or disabled adult; or

2. A caregiver's failure to make a reasonable effort to protect an elderly person or disabled adult from abuse, neglect, or exploitation by another person.

Neglect of an elderly person or disabled adult may be based on repeated conduct or on a single incident or omission that results in, or could reasonably be expected to result in, serious physical or psychological injury, or a substantial risk of death, to an elderly person or disabled adult.

(b) A person who willfully or by culpable negligence neglects an elderly person or disabled adult and in so doing causes great bodily harm, permanent disability, or permanent disfigurement to the elderly person or disabled adult commits a felony of the second degree, punishable as provided in [s. 775.082](#) , [s. 775.083](#) , or [s. 775.084](#) .

(c) A person who willfully or by culpable negligence neglects an elderly person or disabled adult without causing great bodily harm, permanent disability, or permanent disfigurement to the elderly person or disabled adult commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in [s. 775.082](#) , [s. 775.083](#) , or [s. 775.084](#) .

I noticed that in the brief medical intake that occurred after my 8 hours in solitary in a 55 degree room (I was barefoot and clothed in a light t-shirt and shorts) there was no taking of vitals reported. The reason was that I was becoming hypothermic from the 8 hours of solitary in a cell without bedding, only concrete and steel existed in the cell. Deliberately causing physical harm is an assault and battery. Please forward this to the FDLE and U.S. Attorney. My temperature after solitary was 97 which they took but did not disclose in the records the jail produced.

The name of the pharmacy or pharmacist was not provided in the records. I never received the proper literature with any medications provided, a pharmacy error, which would have prevented the Redman Syndrome that caused me medical harm. Had I received the proper paperwork, as regular pharmacies provide, I would have alerted the staff of a toxic medication and I would have refused the offending medication(s). The level of prescribing secrecy and lack of pharmacy information provided to the patient about the drugs dispensed caused the problem.

My blood pressure was taken at least 10 times and recorded by individuals who dispensed medications (I don't know their professional information) and these records were not supplied. They document my out of control blood pressure. Thank you. -- scott huminski

Hello, They finally released my records. I still don't know the professions of any of the names provided, i.e. doctor, nurse, aid, pharmacy tech, etc..

I gave no consent to anyone to stop existing medications or to consent for new medications upon intake to the jail.

I was arrested at approximately 10:30 and got to the Jail at the below time, noon, and immediately was put in solitary for 8 hours as the medical records reflect. If one has diabetes, seizures or many other problems, this custom of warehousing patients for up to 8 hours with no medical information taken could prove deadly to persons with medical issues. During this initial

solitary there was no inquiry if i had food allergies or special/religious food needs and i was provided a meal blindly -- bologna on white. This is dangerous. I was never consulted with by a doctor concerning the vast changes in my medicines or never asked if I had questions for a pharmacist when medicines were dispensed. Note the 7:58 time on the medical history documenting the solitary.

I don't know and never met Andrew Grey, I don't know if this person is a doctor, nurse, pharmacist, and they never mentioned to me they were taking me off medications I have been on for 22 years. My only history of withdrawal was when I ended gabapentin for spine pain and sciatica a year earlier.

Kathy Verdes lied about drug abuse when she stated i take "street drugs" and this contradicts the walmart prescriptions verified on 2/19/2019 which had a xanax prescription. (see attached) I never had this issue and never told her I did. Alprazolam, xanax has been prescribed to me for 22 years, I take it as directed.

Huminski was deprived of all morning medications on 2/27/19 per entry of Karen Hergal, this is common, to get 12 hour medications at far longer or shorter intervals than required. This happened to me many times. There are also an entry of "denies all" that did not happen. Ms. Hergal lied about a history with street drugs.

Prior to administering the first doses of new medications, if I was told they were stopping the treatment that worked well for 22 years, patient should be allowed a consult with a pharmacist or doctor on the new medications.

Note that after side effects from HCTZ (or clonidine) was noted, the toxins that caused Red Man Syndrome (that i was prescribed deltasone for), on 2/19/19 they re-prescribed the toxin and it was delivered to me for a day or two until I noticed problems and I had to interrogate the person dispensing the pills and i had to deny the toxin. My declining the toxin is also in the attached.

Although my blood pressure had been recorded 10 or so times, the report on 2/14/2019 had a blood pressure of 153/114 p 136, revealing the ineffective treatment plan without concern for patient's 22 year history of successful blood pressure management. This is dangerous. I feel symptoms of tightness in chest/anxiety/fear when my blood pressure soars without adequate medical intervention. Elevated blood pressure can cause organ damage, stroke, heart issues

and more. This negatively impacted my anxiety issues because I thought I might die from the extremely high (for me) blood pressure.

See entry of 07/08/2019 [sic] (the date is probably around 2/16/2019) where i emphasize my 20 years of successful medications and relatively good health.

On or about 2/18/2019 i spoke to a female guard via the intercom system and explained that I was given medications that made me ill and required medical intervention, she rudely stated "don't take pills you're not supposed to". I explained the pills were started without me knowing. This is misconduct.

2/27/2019 Brian Medlin lied that i was on social security for drugs problems. I am on social security for joint issues (hips, knees) and for PTSD, Social phobia and generalized anxiety disorder.

In summation, this is the worst medical treatment I have received in my entire life and, at 60 this year, it is the first time I spent in jail. -- scott huminski
