Pursuant to the Massachusetts Public Records Law, I hereby request the following records:

All relevant records pursuant to the investigation of the May 11th, 1956 Bank robbery of the Granite Trust Company (Wollaston Bank Branch) at 80 Beal Street, wherein the sum of \$4,606.55 was stolen. Quincy Officers James E. Ford, Edward E. Kusser and Roy Cavicchi where involved. Suspect ended up wounded and guarded at the Quincy City Hospital.

I also request that, if appropriate, fees be waived as we believe this request is in the public interest, as suggested but not stipulated by the recommendations of the Massachusetts Supervisor of Public Records. The requested documents will be made available to the general public free of charge as part of the public information service at MuckRock.com, processed by a representative of the news media/press and is made in the process of news gathering and not for commercial usage.
