Citizens have a right to obtain a copy of any City procedures for access to records, and to request assistance from the City Freedom of Information Officer. The City may require that requests be submitted in writing; this form is provided for your convenience. If a request is denied, the City must provide specific reasons for denial, and the requester has a right to receive such response in writing. Your request will be acted upon within three business days of the date of the request. If your request is denied or delayed, you will receive a written explanation. You may also contact the City of Leavenworth's Freedom of Information Officer directly to determine if the information you need is available. Be as specific as possible when requesting information.
