

- 1) Any documents sufficient to identify the specific statutes of Mississippi Code which the Mississippi Office of the Attorney General has determined qualify as being included in the 22 disenfranchising general crimes, as described in the Attorney General's Opinion directed to The Honorable Wallace Heggie, dated July 7, 2009.
- 2) Any documents sufficient to explain, describe, or establish when the Office of the Attorney General determined each of the above statutes qualified as a disenfranchising crime.

The requested documents are for academic research and will eventually be made available to the general public, and this request is not being made for commercial purposes.
