ASRC and SAE will not perform any Bathymetry studies or Archaeology studies this year.

ASRC is in the process of purchasing the existing data from the local traditional users in the lagoon areas. This will provide the data we need while creating economic value to the local community.

ASRC has also been engaged with a group of archaeologist and the NSB to cover the needed information for site avoidance for the seismic project.

The summer clean up activities typically takes place in July or early August. The number of helicopter landing will vary depending on camp locations, area of concerns and trash pickup, but should not go over 100 landings.
